NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: **Gulf Yachting Association (GYA)**
Hosted by: **Southern Yacht Club (SYC)**

1 RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events, available at www.gya.org/documents/GYA2019Directory.pdf
- 1.2 The US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.
- 1.3 Appendix V of the RRS will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 All yacht clubs, which are current General Members of the GYA, are eligible to participate in Capdevielle Viper 640s *and the GYA Master's Regatta (in Flying Scots) for the Commodore John Dane Memorial trophy.*
- 2.2 All other classes are open to all sailors.

3. ENTRY AND FEES:

- 3.1 All registration shall take place on-line at Regatta Network <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/18858>
- 3.2 GYA Capdevielle Viper 640s and GYA Master's Regatta -- No fee.
- 3.3 Open Class Flying Scots, Viper 640, Laser, Sunfish, Laser Radial, Club 420, Opti, Fish Class and other OD classes - \$45 (\$5 Discount for US Sailing Members)
- 3.4 Three (3) boats will constitute a class in any one design fleet.

4. NUMBER OF RACES:

Five (5) races are scheduled for all classes of which one (1) will constitute a series.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and on Regatta Network.

7. VENUE

The racing area will be along the South Shore of Lake Pontchartrain approximately 1.5 nm North of SYC.

8. SCORING:

Each class shall be scored using the low point system of Appendix A, except that no races shall be excluded. This changes RRS A2.1.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organizing Authority, nor the Host Club, shall accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after this regatta.

10. SAFETY:

All boats shall comply with United States Coast Guard and State safety equipment regulations. It is the responsibility of each skipper to determine if they should start a race, continue racing, or if wearing a life jacket is appropriate. This does not supersede any class rules or regulations that may require wearing of life jackets while on the water.

11. SUPPORT BOATS:

As races will be sailed back to back, clubs are encouraged to provide support boats for any required on-the-water crew changes.

12. AWARDS:

Awards for Capdevielle Viper 640s and GYA Master's Regatta for the Commodore John Dane Memorial trophy shall be awarded in compliance with GYA regulations 23 and 26. Trophies for one design fleets will be awarded for first place and may be awarded for additional places depending on the number of boats competing in the class.
