NOTICE OF RACE

Harbor 20 Challenge April 20, 2019

1. RULES

- **1.1** The Harbor 20 Challenge will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules governing the Harbor 20 Fleet.
- **1.2** Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

This race is open to all Harbor 20's of which are members of recognized yacht clubs, or sailing organizations, are eligible to compete.

2.1 GREEN REGATTA

This regatta is a Sailors for the Sea "Clean Regatta." As such, all competitors are encouraged to use non-single use water bottles and recycle all appropriate items. Competitors are reminded of rule 55 which states that competitors "shall not intentionally put trash in the water."

3. BOATS/MEASUREMENT

- 3.1 Each competitor will be responsible for their boats being in compliance with the class rules.
- **4. FEES** \$35.00 entrance fee. Need to register before 0900 on the day of the race.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

FIRST START IS AT 12:30 SATURDAY APRIL 20, 2019

- **6. ADVANCE REGISTRATION -** Competitors enter by completing the entry form through Regatta Network. This can be accessed by logging on to ccyc.org Sail Fleet, Racing Information, register.
- 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available at CCYC Sail fleet bulletin board or on line at ccyc.org Sail Fleet, Racing Information
- **8. PENALTY SYSTEM -** Appendix P, Immediate Penalties for Breaking Rule 42, Propulsion, will apply. *[Insert if applicable]*
- 9. SCORING Three races are scheduled. Scoring is per rule 90.3
- **10.SAFETY -** A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee or sailing past but not through the finish line.
- 11. MEDIA RIGHTS By participating in this regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if under age 18) grants to the OA and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

12. DISCIPLINE

- 12.1 All competitors are expected to maintain the highest level of conduct throughout the entire event. When the Protest Committee, from its own observation or a report received from any source believes that a competitor may have committed a breach of a rule, good manners, or sportsmanship, or may have brought the sport into disrepute, it may call a hearing. After a proper hearing the penalty may range from a reprimand to dismissal from the regatta and additional action may be taken under RRS 69.
- **12.2** Hearings will be held generally in accordance with the recommendations of Appendix M5 of the RRS. The officers for hearing a violation will consist of the Chief Judge, acting as chairman of the hearing, the Protest Committee and the event chair.

13. PRIZES

Awards to competitors placing first through third will be presented at the Awards Dinner following the races. The dinner will be \$10 per person. The location of the dinner will be at the CCYC pool.
