NOTICE OF RACE D.J.JOHNSON AROUND OAHU REGATTA

May 25th, 26th & 27th, 2019

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
 - 1.2.2. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.
 - 1.2.3.6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.
 - 1.2.4. Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.
- 1.3. While racing, each competitor will make their position available to the Race Committee via RaceQs app. Competitors are prohibited from tracking one another while racing via RaceQs app

2. **ADVERTISING:** Advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority. All yachts must meet the current ISAF cat 4 safety regulations. Eligible boats are required to register through regatta network. Please refer to:

4. **CLASSES:** Boats will be scored in PH X, A & B, Cruising & Multihull.

5. **FEES:** The entry fees will be \$150.00 for US SAILING member.

7. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network

8. **VENUE:** The waters around the island of Oahu.

9. **COURSES:**
- Day 1 – Waikiki to Kaneohe
 - Day 2 – Kaneohe to Haleiwa
 - Day 3 – Kahe Power Plant to Waikiki

More detailed course information will be in the sailing instructions.

10. **SCORING:** RRS Appendix A2 is modified to allow no throw-outs.

11. **MOORING:** WYC has contacted Ko Olina Marina to secure moorings for entrants but to date we have no guarantee to obtain moorings there. It will be each entrant's responsibility where to secure their boat on the second day (e.g., Haleiwa, Pokai Bay, Ko Olina).
12. **PRIZES:** Prizes will be presented for PH X, A, B, Cruising & Multihull at the awards ceremony
