- 1. RULES** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by the current edition (2017-2020) of the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**
 - 2.1 The event is open to the Flying Scot class only. FSSA membership is not required, but is recommended.
 - 2.2 Eligible competitors may enter the regatta by submitting an entry form and fee to Regatta Network.

 - 6.1 The racing area will be just off the Upper Keys Sailing Club on Buttonwood Sound, Key Largo, Florida.
 - 6.2 Courses will be windward-leeward as described in the sailing instructions.
- 7. SCORING**
 - 7.1 The Low Point Scoring System in Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing will be used. 5 races are scheduled in which 1 must be completed to constitute a Regatta.
 - 7.2 No races will be discarded.
- 8. PRIZES**

Awards for the top three competitors will be presented after the last race on Sunday, May 19, 2019.
