**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**Oceanside Yacht Club - Saturday–May 18, 2019**



## **RULES**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020* (RRS) and the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association except as modified by this notice of race and/or sailing instructions. OYC (Oceanside Yacht Club) is the organizing authority of this regatta to benefit the Women's Resource Center.

## **2.0 ELIGIBILITY**

2.1 The regatta is an open Portsmouth Centerboard class boats with a crew of two and a main and a jib. This includes, but is not limited to Lido 14 and FJ's. 2.2 OYC Club members may reserve a club owned FJ by contacting OYC Fleet Captain Dan Avina ([danavina@hotmail.com](mailto:danavina@hotmail.com)) prior to May 5 to coordinate instruction on rigging and boat handling prior to the event. Reservations are on a first come, first serve basis.

2.3 Wearing of lifejackets (PFD) is required of all participants.

2.4 Yacht club affiliation is not required.

2.5 Mixed gender crew is acceptable, however, a female is required at the helm from first warning signal and the duration of the regatta while racing.

## **3.0 CLASSES**

3.1 Lido and FJ class. Additional classes determined based on entries.

3.2 Subclass of all female crew in each designated racing class.

## **4.0 REGISTRATION**

## **5.0 ENTRY**

5.1 Entry fee is \$25.00. Acceptance of late entries is at the discretion of the Race Chairman and will be subject to an additional late entry fee of \$10.00.

## **8.0 VENUE**

8.1 All classes will race inside the breakwater in the Oceanside Harbor basin. Five races are scheduled.

## **9.0 SCORING**

9.1 The scoring system will be the US Sailing Portsmouth Yardstick.

9.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores; no score shall be excluded. Two completed races are needed to constitute a series.

## **10.0 TROPHIES**

10.01 The number of entries will determine the number of trophies in mixed gender and the subclass of all female crew

10.02 Special Prizes will be awarded to: Youngest Female Sailor, Most Festive Crew, and highest dollar pledge skipper

10.03 Trophy and prizes will be awarded after racing on Saturday, May 18
