

NOTICE OF RACE OFFSHORE RACE #2 May 04, 2019

Organizing Authority is the Lahaina Yacht Club

1. RULES:

The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020; the prescriptions of US Sailing; the prescriptions of HYRA; (except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

VHF radios and GPS are required equipment aboard all boats for this event.

2. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**.

Open to yachts meeting the Maui <u>Safety Equipment Requirements</u> (Maui SER) for Coastal category races, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority. (A word of caution: Please do not enter this race unless you are confident in your boat and your crew's ability to navigate safely in big seas and 20-30 knots true wind speed with possible higher gusts. This is an offshore race in challenging conditions.)

Eligible yachts may be entered by registering with the Race Committee at the mandatory Skippers Meetings and submitting the required fee.

3. **FEES**

The entry fee is \$20.00

4. SCHEDULE.

MANDATORY SKIPPER'S MEETING at 0830 adjacent to MBYC's dock box near slip 25. The first warning will be at approximately 0930 hours,

5. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** will be available at the skipper's meeting.

6. **COURSE**

Course will be determined at the skippers meeting dependent on wind direction and strength.

7. SCORING

Scoring of the event shall be in accord with the PHRF Time-On-Distance Handicap system. The Low Point System will be used to score a yacht's regatta position as modified by HYRA prescriptions. This race will count for season's points as long as a minimum of 3 boats in a class rank as starters (come to the starting line).

8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Race committe and all competitors shall monitor VHF Channel 71

9. **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
