1. RULES

1.1. This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the “*The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017 – 2020*”

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. Eligible boats and drivers may enter by completing an online entry form available through the Regatta Network website at:

2.2. There will be at least two classes, cruising and performance class. Classes may be added depending on participants, 2 or more boats may constitute a new class. Race committee may combine or segregate classes at their discretion.

2.3. The entry fee is \$20 for all boats for each race. Completed entry forms will be accepted by 10:00 HRS on the day of the race at the skippers meeting or online at Regatta Network.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

3.1. The schedule time for the warning signal for the race is 11:55 AM.

3.2. For Race #1 we are running an inverted Start each boat will have a starting time assigned to them.

3.3. The R/C will attempt to have races completing and be back at the club at approximately 16:00 hours.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS / SKIPPERS MEETING

4.1. The Sailing Instructions and classes along with the individual starting times will be posted on Regatta Network site for the race by 1900 hours the night before the race. Sailing instructions will also be available at the Skipper Meeting.

4.2. Skippers meeting will be at PMYC on at 09:00 hours on the day of the race.

5. COURSE / SCORING

- 5.1. Course will be random leg using ASMBYC Marina Del Rey Course Chart 17. For missing marks the use of inflatable orange tetrahedrons marks may be used.
- 5.2. The starting area will be in the vicinity of SS Mark.
- 5.3. Race 1 will be High Point #6: ASMBYC <http://www.asmbyc.org/> King Harbor boats will get a 30% points bonus in the high point series.
- 5.4. Scoring will be high point, TOD PHRF, otherwise standard appendix A.
- 5.5. No races will be excluded.

6. HOSPITALITY

- 6.1. Post-race hospitality and trophy presentation will be held at Pacific Mariners' Yacht Club: 13915 Panay Way, Marina del Rey, CA

7. TROPHIES

- 7.1. Trophies will be presented to the winners of their respective classes.
- 7.2. The Chuck Stein perpetual trophy will be awarded to the winner in the most competitive class across both races in the series at the discretion of the RC.
