**NOTICE OF REGATTA**

**1. Rules:** This regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* for 2017-2020, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, and the rules of the United States Albacore Association, except as any of these are altered by this notice, and by the sailing instructions.

**2. Eligibility and Entry:** This regatta is open to invited one design dinghy classes. Current invited classes are Windmills, Comets, Penguins and Albacores. All registered boats must comply with their Class Association requirements.

**3. Number and Schedule of Races:** Several races may be sailed on any day at the discretion of the race committee (No upper limit). The warning signal for the first race each day scheduled as indicated below:

**4. Social:**

**5. Launching:** MRYC has a crane hoist (lifting harness is not provided), a boat ramp and a small beach for launching by dolly. Boats on dollies may be stored on the grass or near the beach provided they do not block the ramp or access to the hoist. Trailers and vehicles must be moved to the field.

**6. Advance Registration:** Sailors should register in advance r by completing the online attached registration at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19144> .

**7. Fees (US Dollars):** \$45.00 Regatta Registration Fee  
-\$10.00 Discount for US Sailing, CYA or RYA members (have card at check-in)  
Fleets sailing one day( Penquins): \$35.00 Regatta Registration Fee

**8. Safety Equipment:** Each boat must carry safety equipment according to US Coast Guard Regulations or CE certification. (1 PFD per person, sound signal, paddle, bailer). In addition, each boat must carry on board during the regatta a line, suitable for towing, at least 1/4" x 30 feet in length.

**9. Sailing Instructions:** Sailing instructions will be available at the check-in/late registration table and may be posted online prior to May 31, 2019. SIs will govern in case of any inconsistency with this NOR.

**10. Scoring:** The low point system of Appendix A of the RRS will apply. Completion of at least one race shall constitute a series.

One race will be dropped if 6 or more races are sailed.

**11 Awards:**

Awards will be awarded depending on fleet size from online registration.  
Awards will be presented at the awards ceremony following the last days racing.

**12. Accommodations:**

Camping is **NOT** allowed for this event.
