2019 INVITATIONAL REGATTA – July 26-28, 2019
NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 E-Scows will be required to race with Float Packs at the top of the mast.
- 1.3 Appendix V will apply
- 1.4 The Prescriptions RRS 63.2 and RRS 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The following classes are invited to attend: E-Scow, VX One, Lightning, Thistle, SIOD, J/24, Snipe, Hobie 20, Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Sunfish, Y Flyer, C420, 420, Open Bic/Skiff, and Optimist. Classes with four or more boats may request an invitation from the Organizing Authority no later than July 19th, 2019.
- 2.2 Laser class boats may register and sail as Laser Full, Radial or 4.7. A boat must sail the regatta in the rig as registered.

4. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, July 27th	1700-1830 Registration, Under the Boathouse 0900-1030 Registration, Under the Boathouse 1100 Skipper's Meeting, Boathouse 1225 First Warning, other race(s) to follow.
Sunday, July 28th	1200 First Warning, other race(s) to follow. No races will be started after 1500. Awards Ceremony following the Protest Time Limit

5. SOCIAL:

- Continental breakfast under the Boathouse on Saturday and Sunday morning.
- Post-race party following last race on Saturday.

- Sailing participants and guests are invited to enjoy the boathouse and club restaurant for the weekend (cash accepted).

Appropriate attire required for the Club restaurant.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

7. VENUE: Racing will be in Charleston harbor.

8. THE COURSES & CLASS FLAGS: The courses will be “around the buoys” and will be included in the Sailing Instructions. Class flags will be posted by 1100 Saturday.

9. POST RACE PENALTIES/PROTESTS: Appendix V, Section V2 , Post–Race Penalties, will be in effect for this event.

10. SCORING:

10.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply. If less than 6 races are scored, a boat's total score is the sum of all races. If 6 or more are scored then a boat's total score will have one throw out.

10.1 An unlimited number of races are scheduled. One race will constitute a regatta.

12. AWARDS:

- Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of boats competing in each Class.
- Recipients of the CYC Philip O’Neal Harvey Memorial, Henry Clay Robertson IV and Hopkins trophies will be announced at the awards ceremony.
