



2019 Tahoe Laser Fleet Championship Notice of Race

Organizing Authority: Tahoe Yacht Club

1 RULES

- 1.1 This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Rule 40 is changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal floatation devices, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits or dry suits are not personal floatation devices. Flag Y may or may not be displayed.
- 1.3 Except when violating the restricted starting/finishing line Sailing Instruction, rule 44.1 will be changed as follows: A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty as described in rule 44.2 when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 while racing.
- 1.4 U.S. Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 In accordance with RRS 75.1 boats must be entered by competitors who are members of appropriate sailing clubs. Those failing to comply are encouraged to join the Tahoe Yacht Club. Another alternative would be to join the Scuttlebutt Sailing Club at no charge:

- 3.2 This event is open to class-legal Lasers, Laser Radials, and Laser Picos.
- 3.3 Rig swapping between Lasers and Laser Radials is NOT permitted. Competitors must select Full Rig, Radial, or Pico at time of registration.

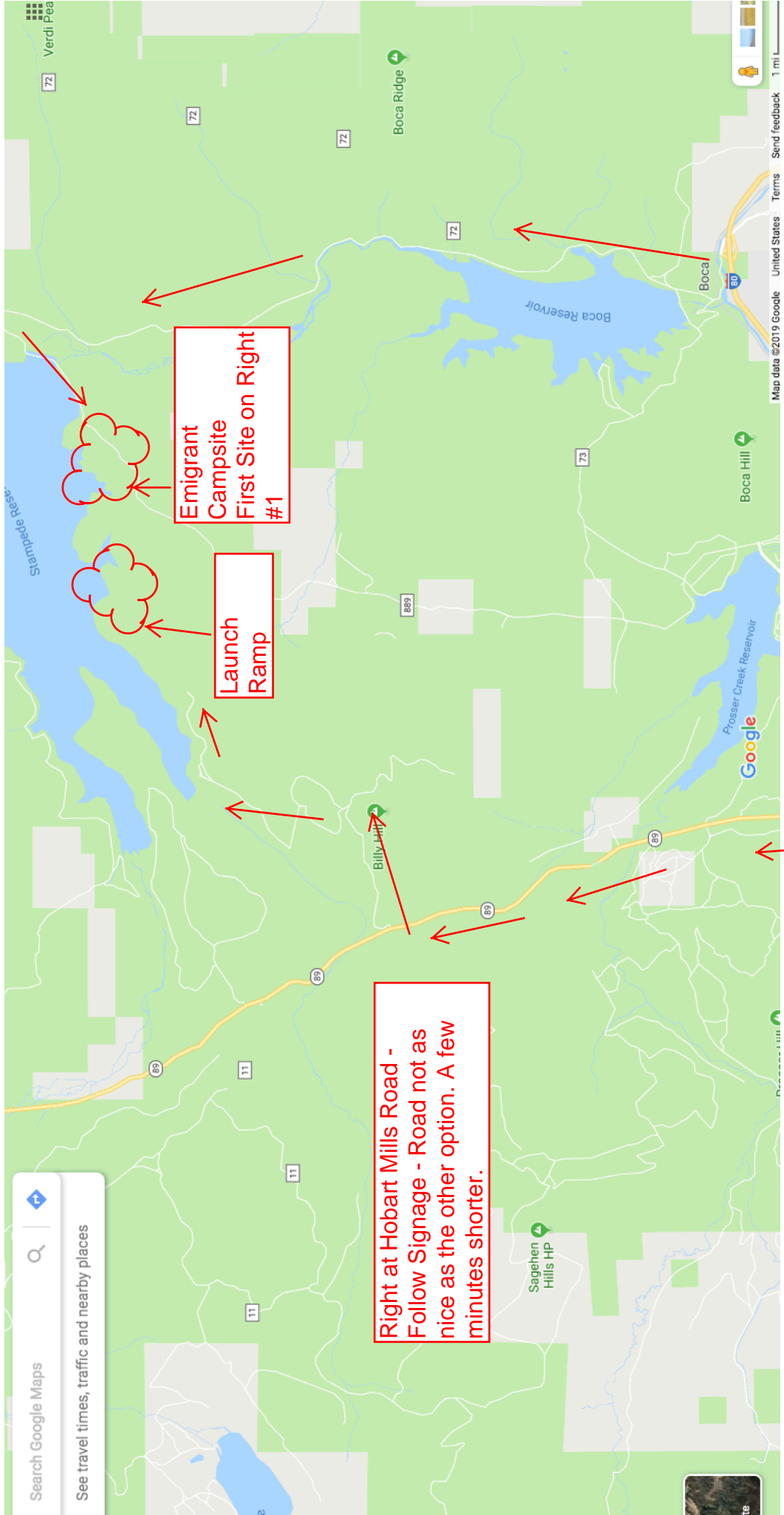
CAMPING

DIRECTIONS AND SITE MAP FOLLOW



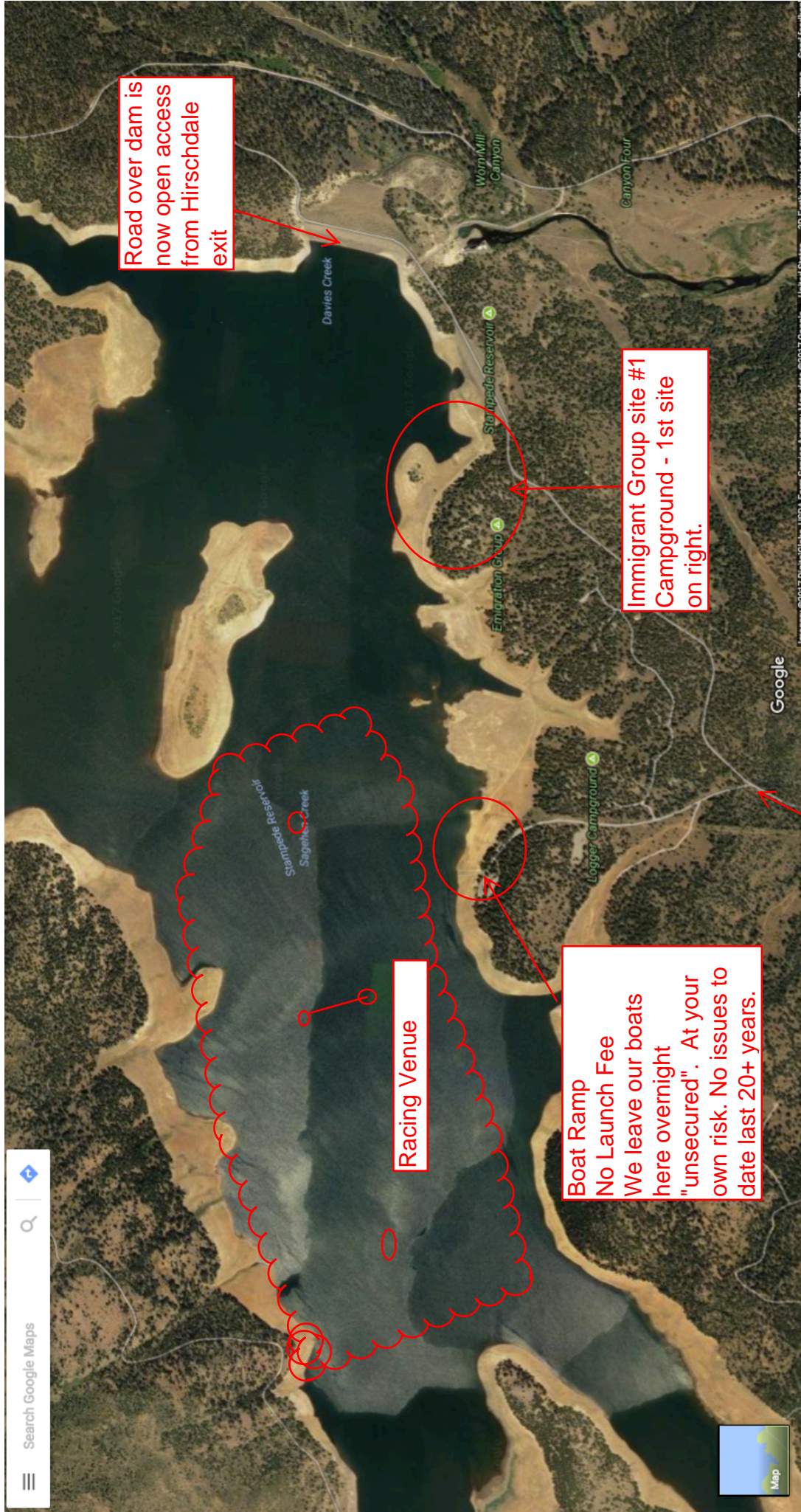
Right at Hobart Mills Road - Follow Signage - Road not as nice as the other option. A few minutes shorter.

Option 2: I-80 to North on Hirschdale Exit (Boca and Stampede Reservoirs). All the way to Stampede, Left over dam.
