

# 2019 SMSA Cumming Cup NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority: Southern Mass Sailing Association  
Host: Pleasant Bay Community Boating & Chatham YC**

**Wednesday June 26, 2019**

## **1. RULES.**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in current *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

## **2. SAFETY**

All competitors must wear properly fastened USCG approved Type III non-inflatable lifejacket at all times while on the water, except to quickly change clothing.

## **3. ELIGIBILITY.**

- 3.1 All competitors must have reached their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday but not their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday during the calendar year.
- 3.2 All competitors must be members in good standing of the same club or sailing organization that is a member of Southern Mass Sailing Association (SMSA)
- 3.3 All competitors should be members of US Sailing.
- 3.4 One entry per SMSA Club
- 3.5 A team consists of three (3) sailors – a skipper and two crew.

## **4. ENTRY.**

- 4.1 Regatta fee is \$125.
- 4.2 All Registration must be done and fees paid on-line at Regatta Networks
- 4.3 Registration opens June 18<sup>th</sup>. Registration closes at 1600 on Monday June 24<sup>th</sup>.
- 4.4 There is a minimum of four (4) boats and a maximum of eight (8) boats on a first come, first serve basis.
- 4.5 SMSA medical forms (or yacht club forms) must be presented at check-in the day of the regatta.

## **5. BOATS.**

- 5.1 Boats are Flying Scots provided by PBCB.
- 5.2 Boats will be rotated. At the discretion of the event chair, clubs may be assigned a boat for more than more race.

## **7. FORMAT:**

- 7.1 A round robin is planned.
- 7.2 The total number of races is at the desecration of the race committee.
- 7.3 Three (3) races constitutes a series.

## **8. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

### **Wednesday, June 26:**

0900 Registration  
0915 Sailors meeting. The time of the first warning will be announced at the sailor's meeting.  
Racing will continue throughout the day at the discretion of the Race Committee. An on-the-water lunch break is planned.

**9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.** Sailing instructions will be posted on Regatta Network and the official notice boards at the regatta site. Paper copies will not be produced.

**10. RACING AREA.** All races will be in Pleasant Bay

### **11. COACHING, SPECTATING, SAFETY BOATS.**

- 11.1 Coaching will be allowed between races.
- 11.2 Coaches, parents, and spectators may not interfere with the racers. Doing so may be grounds for removal of sailors connected to you from the regatta.
- 11.3 There will not be spectator boats available, though the racing can be viewed from shore. All Spectator and/or coach boats must register with the regatta chair before going on the water.
- 11.4 All spectator and/or coach boats are expected to act as safety boats at the direction of the PRO if necessary.

### **12. AREA A SEARS TROPHY QUALIFIER:**

The clubs that finish first qualify to represent SM Sailing in the Area A Sears qualifiers in 2020. SMSA will also reimburse the entry fee for that event.
