Rules: This regatta will be governed by ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 and the prescription of US Sailing and the applicable one-design class associations except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions. The low point scoring system Appendix A will apply. Each boat's score will be the sum of all races.

Registration Details:

Singlehand Registration - \$75.00 – Includes 1 Saturday dinner & Sunday breakfast burrito Doublehand Registration - \$105.00 – Includes 2 Saturday dinners & Sunday breakfast burritos Triplehand Registration - \$135.00 – Includes 3 Saturday dinners & Sunday breakfast burritos

Additional meal tickets - \$30 -Includes Saturday dinner and grab & go breakfast burrito on Sunday.

Camping - \$12 per tent per night and \$5 per car per night, at Beaver Bay Campground Friday and Saturday. Camping Thursday and Sunday at the Beaver Bay Group Camp is free.

Alcohol Free Venue:

Beaver Bay campground and all other PacificCorp properties at Yale Lake are alcohol free. Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages at the park is prohibited.

Park boats at Beaver Bay Campground Launch Ramp Saturday August 3rd
Competitors meeting – 10am at group campsite

Dinner – 6pm (or soon after racing – at the group campground – bring a chair)

Grab & go breakfast burritos
First Warning – 10am
No races will be started after 3pm
There is no limit on the number of races
Awards and get together at Beaver Bay swim area (next to launch ramp) after racing
Camping in group campsite

Eligibility: This regatta is open to one design dinghy fleets, for example, Lidos, Lasers, Thistles, Daysailers, Flying Scots, 505's, and Geary 18s. Three boats will constitute a fleet. If there is sufficient interest, we will provide a start and scoring for a Portsmouth fleet.

Racing: We are planning on sailing as many races as possible. Two races will constitute a regatta. There will be no races started after 3pm on Sunday.

Launching/Parking: All boats will be kept and launched from the Beaver Bay campground. All cars will remain parked at the camp sites. Skippers meeting, Saturday dinner, and Sunday breakfast will be held at the group campsite at Beaver Bay. The park has real restrooms, a small dock and overnight (mast-up) boat parking. For more information please follow the link <u>HERE</u>. Competitors are welcome to launch at Yale Park at their own expense, but no overnight boat storage will be available there.

Lodging or Camping Options: We have reserved the Beaver Bay group camp (Thurs thru Sunday) and some individual sites Friday and Saturday nights (tent and non-hookup small campers only). Thursday night and Sunday night camping at the group camp is free. (You can also leave your tent up until after racing on Sunday.) The town of Cougar WA is very close and has other lodging options like B&B, full hookup RV sites, store, gas station and several restaurants.
