NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The prescriptions of US Sailing shall apply. GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events, Regulation 40, shall apply to boats competing in the GYA Women's PHRF Championship. <u>Co-Skippers are allowed</u>. GYA-PHRF class rules shall apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. All boats must have a current GYA PHRF Certificate.
- 2.2. GYA Women's PHRF Championship and Roses 100% women crew.
- 2.3. GYA Women's PHRF Championship is Spinnaker only. Boats may enter Roses in either Spinnaker or Non-Spinnaker Fleet.
- 2.4. Boat entering the GYA Women's PHRF Championship will be dual scored with the Roses Spinnaker Fleet.

3. FEES

3.1. Entry Fee: Spinnaker Fleet \$60. Non-Spinnaker Fleet \$30. Entry Fee covers both GYA Women's PHRF Championship and Race for the Roses.

4. TRILOGY SERIES:

4.1. The Race for the Roses Regatta is part of Point Yacht Club's three race "Trilogy Series". Boats competing the Trilogy Series should consult Point Yacht Club for Eligibility, Entry, and other Trilogy Series requirements.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1. Spinnaker Fleet - Three Races are scheduled. Non-Spinnaker Fleet - One race is scheduled.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. The current version of the "Pensacola Bay General Sailing Instruction" shall be the Sailing Instructions for this event. A copy of these SI's is available for download within this event's Regatta Network website.
- 6.2. Supplemental SI's specific for this event will be available at registration.

7. VENUE

7.1. The races will be held within the Pensacola Bay area refer to Appendix B of the SI's

8. THE COURSES

8.1. The Spinnaker fleet courses will be custom windward-leeward. The Non-Spinnaker fleet course will be a triangle course.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1. RRS Appendix V, "Alternative Penalties" shall apply.

10. SCORING

10.1. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A shall apply. One race constitutes a Series. One throw-out if three races are completed.

11. PRIZES

11.1. Winner of the GYA Women's PHRF Championship is eligible to receive the Pensacola Beach Yacht Club Perpetual Trophy (See GYA Reg 40.6). Trophies will be award to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place boats in each class. The Amada Werner Overall Spinnaker Trophy will be awarded. Other trophies will be awarded.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
