## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1\* The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the rules of PHRF Southern California and San Diego.
- 1.2 Racing rules will be changed as follows: For all classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty; and in regard to RRS A2.1, the first sentence of that paragraph is changed by deleting “excluding her worst score” and replacing it with “no score will be excluded.”

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to any member in good standing of a San Diego area yacht club.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter online by means of Regatta Network at [www.nycsd.club](http://www.nycsd.club) by midnight, July 19, 2019.

### 3 FEE

There is a \$25.00 25 fee to race.

### 4 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

The regatta will consist of three races held on Saturday, July 20, 2018.

### 5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: Open to 19 July 2019 at midnight.
- 5.2 Dates of racing: 21 July 2018, First race at 12 noon.
- 5.3 Number of races: Three races are planned. Less than three races may be sailed depending on conditions.
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the 11:55 am.
- 5.5 No warning signal will be made after 1530.
- 5.6 BBQ after the race with Italian theme – Cost \$20. Per adult/10 Children under 12. Tickets available in Ships Store and upon Race registration. BBQ sales close 19 July, no ticket sales day of event.

### 6 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall enter classes using their Random Leg Class (RLC) handicap rating.

## **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will consist of the 20189South Bay Clubs Standard Sailing Instructions Version Date: January 20189 and the host club's Regatta Amendment. Instructions will be posted online on Regatta Network section of [www.nycsd.club](http://www.nycsd.club) and on the official notice board located at Navy Yacht Club San Diego's clubhouse, Fiddler's Cove, Strand Highway, San Diego.

## **8 VENUE**

Races to be sailed in South San Diego, south of the Coronado Bay Bridge and approximately east of Fiddler's Cove, Route 75, Coronado, CA.

## **9 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be Windward- Leeward. Course diagrams and numbering to be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

## **10 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 10.1 For all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 10.2 RRS A2.1 The first sentence of that paragraph is changed by deleting "excluding her worst score" and replacing it with "no score will be excluded."
- 13.3 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

## **11 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. Race Committee will monitor Channel 68, a VHF channel.

## **12 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows: Number of boats in class : 1-4, one prize.  
Number of boats in class: 5-7, two prizes  
Number of boats in class: 8-12, three prizes

## **13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
