

NOTICE OF RACE LYC SUMMER SERIES June 29, 2019 & July 6, 2019

Organizing Authority is the Lahaina Yacht Club.

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020; the prescriptions of US Sailing; the prescriptions of HYRA; (except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions).

2. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**.

Open to yachts meeting the Maui <u>Safety Equipment Requirements</u> (Maui SER) for Nearshore category races, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority. Eligible yachts may be entered by registering with the Race Committee at the Competitors Meeting and submitting the required fee.

3. **FEES**

The entry fee is \$20.00

4. SERIES SCHEDULE.

Competitors Meetings at 10:30 hours at Lahaina Harbor near Lele's slip. The first warning will be at approximately 1155 hours. The warning signal for the second and third races will be approximately 10 minutes after the last boat finishes the preceding race. A total of three races are planned each day for a total of 6 races.

5. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** will be available at the skipper's meeting.

6. **COURSE**

The races will be conducted offshore from the vicinity of Puamana.

7. SCORING

Scoring of the event shall be in accord with the PHRF Time-On-Distance Handicap system. The Low Point System will be used to score a yacht's regatta position as modified by HYRA prescriptions. The individual races in this regatta will count for season's points as long as a minimum of 3 PHRF-A

boats rank as starters (come to the starting line).

8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Race committee and all competitors shall monitor VHF Channel 71

9. **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
