NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2017 – 2020 (RRS)*.
- 1.2 All boats shall be in compliance with their respective class rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats in the following one-design classes: Optimist (White, Blue, Red and Green), Star, Jr 420, Jr Laser, Jr Laser Radial, Snipe, Penguin, Comet, Adult Laser, Adult Laser Radial and Albacore.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 0900 Saturday, August 10. On-line registration is required.
- 2.3 Races may be cancelled for any class listed above if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by 1600 on Friday, August 9.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$30 for single and \$40 for double if USSA or CBYRA members. Add \$5 for non-members. Fees to be received no later than 0930 on Saturday, August 10.

- 4.12 1630. Trophy presentation at Harleigh (coat and tie required)

Note: No warning signals after 1330

5 LAUNCHING

- 5.1 Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers must be stored in designated areas clear of hoist and access lanes.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website by 1600 on August 3 and in the clubhouse on race days.

7 THE VENUE

- 7.1 Course **Charlie** will be in the Choptank River to the south or southwest of Choptank Light.
- 7.2 All other one-design courses will use drop marks in the Tred Avon River in the following general areas: **Bravo**, south of TAYC clubhouse between mark "R2" and Pier St.; **Delta**, south of clubhouse near Pier St.; **Foxtrot**, south of clubhouse near Foxhole Creek; **Echo**, north of clubhouse near Town Creek. Specific locations for each course will be described at Competitors' meetings.

8 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 8.1 A boat that retires or leaves the racing area between races shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 8.2. Competitors are strongly encouraged to wear a USCG approved PFD while racing.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 finishers, 2 if 5 finishers, 3 if 7 or more finishers.
- 10.2 Certain classes may award special trophies in addition to the above.
- 10.3 Prizes will be awarded at 1630 at Harleigh (see 4.12). Results will be posted at www.tayc.com/racing.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
