

# BARNEGAT BAY STAR CHAMPIONSHIP Toms River Yacht Club Riviera Parkway, Toms River, NJ 08753 August 24-25,2019 NOTICE OF RACE

## 1 Rules

- **1.1.** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017- 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR).
- **1.2.** The Organizing Authority is Toms River Yacht Club in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA).
- **1.3.** Applicable US Sailing Prescriptions are stated in full in Attachment 1.
- **1.4**. RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- **1.5.** STCR 35.5 changes RRS 44.2 to indicate that the penalty is a one turn penalty including one tack and one jibe.
- **1.6.** RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- **1.7.** STCR 31.2.6 will be modified to allow VHF radios to be carried on all boats for the sole purpose to listen in to actions of the Race Committee and to transmit in the event of an emergency on a specific channel designated in the Sailing Instructions. The RC will attempt to notify all boats that are OCS by VHF radio. Failure to do so by RC or the order in which boats are notified shall not be grounds for redress.

# 2 Advertising:

Boats may be required to display Event Advertising on the forward part of the hull.

# 3 Eligibility and Entry

- **3.1.** Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26, 29 and 30 may compete.
- **3.2.** Entries shall be submitted on the Official Online Entry Form not later than 1000 hours on the day of the first race.
- **3.3.** Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under the World Sailing Eligibility Code shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.
- **3.4.** For the purpose of RRS Appendix A Scoring: A competitor is not considered an entry until all fees are paid.

# 4 Fees & Registration

- 4.1. Registration will be available online at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19358
- 4.2 The registration fee will be \$135.

- **4.3**.A \$25 late fee will be assessed to anyone signing up the morning of the event up until 1000 hours when registration ends. Those who sign up the morning of the event at the TRYC Chart Room shall pay online by credit card.
- **4.4**. Entry fees include boat and trailer launching, hauling and storage commencing at 0800 the day before the regatta until 24 hours after the conclusion of racing

### **5 Schedule of Races Events:**

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race Saturday is 11:30 and 11:00 Sunday. Up to 5 races will be sailed. No race will start after 1530 on Sunday. There will be a competitors meeting at 0930 on Saturday. There will be free beer and snacks after sailing both days. Cash bar will be open and Restaurant will be open on Friday night.

# **6 Sailing Instructions:**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration desk.

### 7 Venue:

Racing will be conducted on Barnegat Bay or in the Toms River Conditions dependent. The RC will notify competitors of sailing area at the skippers meeting each day.

### 8 Courses:

Courses will be according to STCR 34. Courses marked with a "V" after the Course Number will include the Vertical Offset at Mark 1 (see Attachment 2).

# 9 Scoring:

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each regatta's score will be the total of her races scored (no drop).

### 10 Housing:

### 12 Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded to boats that place 1st through 3rd.
