NOTICE OF RACE





2019 Junior Olympic Windsurfing Festival & All Island Regatta Techno 293 and Kona One Design

August 1-2, 2019 Vineyard Haven YC, Vineyard Haven, MA on the island of Martha's Vineyard

The 2019 US Sailing Junior Olympic Festival Event, and the All Island Windurfing Regatta, will be hosted by the Vineyard Haven Yacht Club, August 1 & 2, 2019 (Thursday & Friday). **This will be an all-family festival of windsurfing.**

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2019, including U.S. Windsurfing Association Prescriptions, the Sailing Instructions, the Techno 293 Class Rules (with amended rig prescriptions), and the Kona One Class Rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY, EQUIPMENT, and ENTRY

All competitors in the Techno 293 Class must be members of US Sailing (for U.S. citizens). The T293 fleet will be scored in four age groups: Under 13, U15, U17, and Open Age Group. Eligibility in an age group is dictated by your age as of August 1, 2019.

A minimum of three competitors is necessary to constitute an age group class. Otherwise, age groups will be combined.

3 EQUIPMENT

3.1 Techno 293 One Design boards will be eligible with the following rig modifications. Open rigs are permitted under the following USWA prescriptions as modified below.

Under 13 (U13) years old	-	Maximum sail size 5.8m
Under 15 (U15) years old	-	Maximum sail size 6.8m
Under 17 (U17) years old	-	Maximum sail size 7.8m
Open Age Group	-	Maximum sail size 8.5m

3.2a Per USWA prescriptions, sails with more than 3 cambers and/or 7 battens are prohibited.

3.2b Only masts from the approved class list with no more than 75 percent carbon and weight equivalents are permitted.

3.2c Booms are restricted to alloy/aluminum construction. Note that carbon booms are not permitted under class rules

3.2d Only original fins or manufacturers' replacements permitted. The maximum fin size under class rules is 46 cm. (50cm for Open Age Group)

3.2e Techno 293 Class Rules are available at http://www.techno293.org/ Eligible sail sizes and age groups have been modified by this Notice of Race and USWA prescriptions.

3.2d Kona One Design will be per Kona Class Rules.

4 FEES

4.1 The regatta entry fee is \$40. Entry fee includes lunch on Thursday and Friday.

5 SCHEDULE

This event is focused on improvement, comraderie, and fun. There will be scored racing for the All-Island regatta as well as possible instruction/clinic depending on wind conditions. We are intentionally being flexible with the schedule to take advantage of optimum wind/weather conditions for the racing.

6 VENUE

Racing will take place in Vineyard Haven Harbor known for its protected waters and good winds. Sailors are guests of Vineyard Haven Yacht Club.

7 THE COURSES

7.1 The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will be used.
- 8.2 Competitors will have one race discarded for every four races completed.
- **8.3** Two races are required to constitute the Championship.
- **9 PRIZES** Prizes will be awarded to competitors placing in respective divisions.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The event organizers, Vineyard Haven Yacht Club, its employees, volunteers, and staff will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11 HOUSING

12 TRAVEL TO MARTHA'S VINEYARD

This is peak season on the island of Martha's Vineyard so getting there can be a challenge, but once you're there everything will be easy. You will not need a car on the Vineyard as we can pick you up from the ferry and everything in Vineyard Haven is within walking distance of Vineyard Haven Yacht Club. If you are planning on bringing your vehicle, you should carpool and make your reservations now. Reservations are not necessary for walk-on passengers or boards. The best ferry from Woods Hole. MA service is to Vinevard Haven. See www.steamshipauthority.com for ferry schedules and parking information. There is also the fast ferry from New Bedford, MA at www.nefastferry.com which only takes passengers and gear. Another option for passengers and gear is the Island Queen from Falmouth to Oak Bluffs at www.islandqueen.com.

There are three options for air travel. Fly to Boston Logan airport (BOS), Providence RI airport (PVD) or the smaller Martha's Vineyard airport (MVY). If you are chartering boards, you can take the bus from Logan airport to Woods Hole on Peter Pan/Bonanza Bus www.peterpanbus.com The bus service is easy and picks up right at the terminal and drops off right at the Woods Hole ferry. The bus from Providence requires connections. For groups of kids, we may be able to arrange pick up by boat from Falmouth Town Pier.
