

William H. Myers Heritage Regatta Shields and Star Classes August 24-25, 2019 Tred Avon Yacht Club Oxford, MD

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, 2017 2020 (RRS).
- 1.2 All boats shall be in compliance with their respective class rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Star and Shields Class boats whose owners are members of their respective class associations.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (<u>www.tayc.com/racing</u>) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 0900 Saturday, August 24. On-line registration is required.

3 FEES

3.1 The entry fee for Stars is \$40 for USSA or CBYRA members. Add \$5 for non-members. Fees to be received no later than 0900 on Saturday, August 24. Shields entry fee has been prepaid.

4 SCHEDULE

Note: The Race Committee will attempt to run five races over the course of the weekend <u>Saturday:</u>

- 4.1 0800-0930 Free coffee, juice, bagels
- 4.2 0845 Competitors' meeting between TAYC clubhouse and main bulkhead
- 4.4 1025 Warning signal, Race 1, Stars
- 4.5 1030 Warning signal, Race 1, Shields
- 4.7 1600 Galley Window open

Note: No warning signals after 1430

Sunday:

- 4.9 0800-0930 Full breakfast available for purchase
 - 4.10 0845 Competitors' meeting between TAYC clubhouse and main bulkhead
 - 4.11 1025 Warning signal, Stars
 - 4.12 1030 Warning signal, Shields

Note: No warning signals after 1330

5 LAUNCHING

5.1 Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers must be stored in designated areas clear of hoist and access lanes.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website by 1600 on August 17 and in the clubhouse on race days.

7 THE VENUE

7.1 Courses will use drop marks in the Choptank River southwest of Choptank River Light or in the Tred Avon River.

8 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 8.1 A boat that retires or leaves the racing area between races shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity by hail or on VHF channel 68.
- 8.2. Competitors are strongly encouraged to wear a USCG approved PFD while racing.

9 SCORING

9.1 One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 finishers, 2 if 5 finishers, 3 if 7 or more finishers.
- 10.2 Prizes will be awarded following racing on Sunday. Results will be posted at <u>www.tayc.com/racing.</u>
