Event: The Corinthian Sailing Club (OA) cordially invites you to a one-day, open regatta for all centerboard boats and the Corinthian Class Keel Boat.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

Entry: Registration may be completed online at www.cscsailing.org. Late registration (after Saturday, October 5) may be completed online or at the regatta site at 441 E Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218. Sailing Instructions will be available at check in.

Regatta Plan: The State Fair Regatta is a one-day regatta with three to five races planned. Three or more boats will race as a class. Boats that do not form a one design class will be assigned to a Portsmouth handicap class.

Fees: Double handed boats advance, online\$45.00
 Double handed boats, after Sat. October 5.....\$50.00
 NOTE: Includes Corinthians

Single handed boats advance, online.....\$25.00
 Single handed boats, after Sat. October 5.....\$30.00
 NOTE: Includes Optimist

Fees include for all competitors, breakfast, lunch, post-race snacks and refreshments.

Regatta t-shirts are long-sleeve dry-fit and may be purchased separately for \$20. To guarantee yourself a t-shirt, please order it online before October 5th. T-shirts will not be available to order online after October 5th. Some extra t-shirts *may be available* for purchase at registration but there will not be many.

Courses: Two courses are planned. One race constitutes a regatta. The courses to be sailed are those specified in the Corinthian Sailing Club Sunday Joint Race Program Sailing Instructions.

Schedule:

8:30 – 9:30 Breakfast, check-in and late registration.

9:45 Skippers meeting.

10:30 Warning signal for the first race.

- One or two races are scheduled prior to lunch.
- Lunch break at the dock.
- Additional races will follow the lunch break.

Snacks and refreshments will be provided and awards will be given at the clubhouse after the races.

Scoring: The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in each class, depending on the number of boats registered.
