

NOTICE OF RACE
Laser District 18 Grand Prix
The Foundry
September 28-29, 2019

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING), the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) and this Notice of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions or this Notice of Race.
- 1.2. Appendix V1 and Appendix V2 shall be in effect.

2. INSPECTION & MEASUREMENT

- 2.1. Each boat shall comply with class rules and may be inspected for compliance at any time during the regatta at the discretion of the race committee.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1. Laser and Radial competitors who are members of the ILCA or their national Laser Class Association may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority. A minimum of five entries are required to constitute a class.
- 3.2. Competitors shall wear a US Coast Guard approved Type III or V Personal Floatation Device which is inherently buoyant while on the water, except for brief periods while changing clothing.

4. RISK

- 4.1. It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

1000 Skipper's Meeting

1100 First Warning, Racing to Follow

1400 No Race Started After

Awards to immediately follow racing

6. REGISTRATION & FEES

- 6.1. Registration shall be on-site and online at regattanetwork.com.
- 6.2. The registration deadline is Friday, September 27th at 1900.

- 6.3. Entry fee is \$40 per competitor.
- 6.4. All competitors must complete a Foundry Waiver and Emergency Medical Information Form, which are available at regattanetwork.com and on-site. Participants under the age of 18 must have parent/guardian signature on these documents.
7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
 - 7.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at regattanetwork.com and on-site during the regatta.
8. SCORING
 - 8.1. Low point scoring will be used.
 - 8.2. A “throwout” shall be given after every sixth completed race.
9. AWARDS
 - 9.1. Awards may be presented to the top 3 finishers in each fleet (Laser & Radial).
 - 9.2. Other awards may be given.
10. LOGISTICS
 - 10.1. Boat storage and launching will be at the Station. Details are pending; information will be sent to competitors.
