# **NOTICE OF RACE v3 9/2/2019**

#### **1 RULES**

**1.1** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

**1.2** Racing Rules of Sailing Part 4 preamble will be changed as follows: When flag Y is displayed ashore, RRS 40 applies at all times while afloat. Racing rule A4.1 will be changed as follows: A boat starting later than four (4) minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. Racing rule 33 will be changed as follows: During the race, "gate" marks may be repositioned without signal for minor changes in course. Racing rules 35 and A4.1 will be changed as follows: Boats failing to finish within thirty (10) minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish. Sailing instructions may be modified verbally on the water

## 2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A as stated in ISAF Regulation 20.

## **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

**3.1** The regatta is open to the following classes: M16, MC16.

## 4 FEES

4.1 Entire Series: \$40.00.

#### 4.2 Daily: \$20.00.

#### **5 QUALIFICATION**

**5.1** In order to be scored for series awards a boat must register for the entire. Although scored, daily entries are not eligible to receive any series awards. To be eligible for series awards a series registration is required.

#### **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available before the first race of the series.

#### 8 VENUE

Manasquan River between the Route 35 Bridge and the canal.

#### **9 THE COURSES**

Windward/Leeward/Triangular/Around the Buoys courses.

#### **10 SCORING**

10.1 The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.

## **10.2** The number of scheduled races is 15 of which 3 must be completed to constitute the series.

**10.3** A registered boat that does not come to the starting line will be scored DNC.


**10.4** The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply as changed below. RRS A2 is changed so one (1) race will be excluded for every four (4) races completed.

**10.5** No race shall be declared official unless three or more entrants come to the starting line. **11 BERTHING** 

Boat Storage is available free of charge, to those registered for the series. Skippers intending to store their boat at MRYC during the series should notify MRYC's dockmaster at 732-528-6792 in advance of arriving.

#### **12 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.





#### **13 REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

**Notes:** 1. Manual bailer must be a minimum of 4-quart capacity.

2. All boats must carry a towline solely dedicated to towing and/or anchoring and readily available for use at all times. Line must be at least 24' long and of sufficient strength to tow a swamped boat.

#### 14 AWARDS

14.1 Awards will be presented at the annual MRYC Sailing Awards Dinner in November.

#### **15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

#### 16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of the policy limit of their homeowner's insurance policy per event or the equivalent thereof.
