NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority will be the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, Long Beach, CA.

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than qualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2. RRS 26 will be changed as follows: Warning signal will be given three (3) minutes before the starting signal. The Preparatory signal will be given two (2) minutes before the Starting signal.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to boats of the Naples Sabot class (Ladies A, Ladies B, Mens and Mixed C Divisions).
- 2.2. This regatta is open to members' "in good standing" of US Sailing Association affiliated yacht clubs or Sailing Organizations, and to foreign sailors who are members of their respective National Governing Authorities.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter online by completing the on-line registration at Regatta Network or in person.
- 2.4. Online entries will be accepted until 1600 on the Friday immediately preceding the regatta; thereafter entries may only be made in person. In-person entries will be accepted until 0930 on regatta morning.
- 2.5. Five (5) PAID entries are required to establish a class. Classes may be started together but scored separately.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The fee for this regatta is \$30
- 3.2. A light post-race dinner is part of registration.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Registration will be open at 0800 on the day of the regatta.
- 4.2. A competitors' meetings will be held on the ABYC patio on Saturday at 1030 for all classes.
- 4.3. Number of Races – Four (4) races are scheduled
- 4.4. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1157
- 4.5. No warning signal will be made after 1600.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The sailing instructions will be available at registration and online.

6. VENUE

- 6.1. Races will be held in Alamitos Bay

7. SCORING

- 7.1. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8. PARKING AND STORAGE

- 8.1. Due to space limitations, vehicle parking on ABYC grounds is restricted. Off-street parking is available across the street in municipal lots.
- 8.2. The Regatta fee includes launching, recovery, and storage for visiting competing boats from the day prior to the event until the day following the event. [DP]

- 8.3. Visiting competing boats may request extended storage IN ADVANCE by contacting the ABYC office. The cost is \$10.00 per day paid in advance. [DP]
- 8.4. Any boat or trailer found on ABYC property without prior written authorization from ABYC is subject to impound and associated fees. [DP]

9. HOSPITALITY

- 9.1. The hospitality of ABYC is extended to all participants.
- 9.2. The Galley will be open. Regatta Breakfast menu and bag lunches will be available.
- 9.3. An Oktoberfest dinner is scheduled after racing.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. Prizes will be awarded to the following schedule:

Five (5) boats	One (1) trophy;
Six (6) to Eight (8)	Two (2) trophies;
Nine (9) to 11	Three (3) trophies;
12 to 14	Four (4) trophies;
15 or more	Five (5) trophies.

- 10.2. The following perpetual trophies will be awarded:

Ruth M. Russell	Awarded to the woman skipper with the best performance
Christine Wagner	Awarded to the highest placing ABYC woman member in the most competitive fleet

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. SAFETY

- 12.1. ABYC recommends that all competitors wear personal flotation devices while on the water.
- 12.2. ABYC yard rules do not allow dogs, other than service dogs, onto the property or boat yard. [DP]
