NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, 2017 2020 (RRS).
- 1.2 All boats shall be in compliance with their respective class rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Penguin and Comet class boats.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (<u>www.tayc.com/racing</u>) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 0930 on Saturday, November 2. Online registration is required.
- 2.3 Races may be cancelled for a class if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by 1600 on Thursday, October 31.

3 FEES

3.1 The entry fee is \$25 for CBYRA or USSA members, \$30 for non-members, to be received no later than 0930 on Saturday, November 2.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 0830-0930 Free coffee, juice and bagels available in clubhouse; bag lunches (\$8) may be purchased.
- 4.2 0945 Competitors' Meeting
- 4.3 1045 Warning gun for first class
- 4.4 As many races as possible will be sailed, but no race will start after 1430.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website no later than one week prior to race day and on race day in the clubhouse.

6 THE VENUE

6.1 Races will be sailed in the Tred Avon River using drop marks. Exact location to be announced by PRO at Competitors' Meeting.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 A boat's regatta score shall be the total of all her race scores unless five or more races have been completed, in which case her worst score will be excluded, subject to Rule 90.3(b).
- 7.2 At least one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

8 PRIZES

- 8.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 finishers, 2 if 5 finishers, 3 if 7 or more finishers.
- 8.2 Prizes will be presented on the first floor of the TAYC clubhouse as soon as possible after the conclusion of racing.
- 8.3 Results will be posted at <u>www.tayc.com/racing.</u>
