#### 1. RULES:

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** "The Texas Youth Racing Circuit Conditions" apply and are available on the web site at <a href="http://www.txsail.org/">http://www.txsail.org/</a>. A copy will also be available at the regatta site.
- **1.3** The rules for all classes are altered so that membership in a class organization is not required.
- **1.4** Racing Rules 61.1(a), Protest Requirements and Appendix A2, Scoring Systems are modified for this series. Racing Rule 49.1 is changed to allow the use of hiking pants.
- **1.5** All boats shall have sail numbers which match the registration form. Sail numbers meeting class standards are required.

#### 2. ADVERTISING:

**2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist, Laser (Full, Radial and 4.7, Open BIC) and Double-Handed (420 Club, 420 Collegiate, I-420, FJ or other double handed boat as designated by the host club). All classes are "bring your own boat"; however, DCYC has a limited number of Optimist, 420 Collegiate and Open BIC boats available for charter. Contact the Chairperson to charter a boat. A minimum of three boats is required to form a class. All boats shall have identifiable sail numbers. Sail numbers meeting class standards are encouraged.
- **3.2** The regatta is open to all junior sailors who are less than twenty years old and who do not turn twenty years of age during this calendar year.
- **3.3** Optimists are sailed in four fleets:
- **3.3.1** Green Fleet: Open to all novice sailors under age 15 and through 12/31 of the calendar year in which they turn age 15
- 3.3.2 White Fleet: Age 10 and under
- **3.3.3** Blue Fleet: Age 11 12
- **3.3.4** Red Fleet: Age 13 15
- **3.3.5** For Optimist White, Blue and Red fleets, skipper's age on the first day of the regatta determines his or her fleet. Skippers move fleets on their 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthdays. Those turning 15 may continue in Red fleet through 12/31 of that year.
- 4. ENTRY FEE: The early registration entry fee is \$60.00 for each sailor, whether in single or double-handed boats. Late registration entry fee of \$65.00 begins on Monday, October 7, 2019. The entry fee includes one (1) regatta T-Shirt and the following meals for each sailor: breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday and [breakfast and lunch on Sunday. Meal tickets will be available for non-competitors for an extra charge of \$20.00 for an all-inclusive wristband, or individual tickets for \$10.00 for Saturday dinner, and \$8.00 for Saturday or Sunday lunch. Additional t-shirts are

also available for \$20.00. Make all registration checks payable to **DALLAS CORINTHIAN YACHT CLUB.** 

#### 5. REGISTRATION AND CHECK IN:

- 5.1 Pre-Registration is encouraged and may be completed online at <a href="www.txsail.org">www.txsail.org</a> or <a href="www.txsail.org">www.txsail.org</a> or by calling Michele Ditmer at 214-697-5447 or by email at <a href="micheleditmer@gmail.com">micheleditmer@gmail.com</a>.
- 5.2 Registration and check-in at the regatta will be conducted on Saturday, October 12, 2019, between 8 am and 9:30 am in the upstairs clubhouse. Execution of a Liability Release Agreement as set forth in the Registration Form shall be required. Parents are urged to provide a signed Medical Consent Form to enable other adults to obtain emergency medical services in the event of the parents' unavailability during the regatta.
- **5.3** All sailors are **required to check in** by 9am on Saturday at the registration table, even if the sailor pre-registered by mail or other means.

#### 6. SCHEDULE:

- **6.1** Subject to the decisions of the Race Committee, six or more races are scheduled. One or more races will constitute a regatta. If five or more races are completed, there will be one throw out race for scoring purposes. If ten or more races are completed there will be one additional throw out two total for scoring purposes.
- **6.2** The schedule for the regatta is:

After Racing Awards Ceremony

- **6.3** No warning signal for a race will be given after 1700 on Saturday and 1330 on Sunday.
- **6.4** Attendance at the **Skippers' Meeting** held at 0930 on Saturday of the regatta at the Clubhouse is mandatory.
- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration and posted on the Notice Board on the south wall of the Clubhouse. Sailing Instructions may also be posted at the TSA Website (www.txsail.org).
- **8. VENUE:** Races will be conducted on the waters of Lake Lewisville.
- **9. COURSES:** All fleets will typically sail windward/leeward, triangle, or Olympic courses.
- **10. SAFETY:** A U.S. Coast Guard approved personal buoyancy device will be worn by all competitors while on the water. Wet or Dry suits are not considered adequate

buoyancy devices for this purpose. All buoyancy devices shall be worn on the outside of all clothing.

## 11. DISCIPLINE:

- 11.1 Per US SAILING Regulation 5.03 no contestant shall use, either on or off the water, during any Texas Sailing Association Junior event: marijuana or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802) the possession of which is unlawful under 21 U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine and beer, each as defined in chapter 51 of the U.S: IRC Code and intended for beverage use). This regulation is in effect from date and time of arrival through date and time of departure from the locale. The penalty shall be that the contestant after a proper hearing, be immediately removed from the regatta venue and, where practical, sent home.
- 11.2 All competitors, coaches and parents are expected to maintain the highest level of conduct throughout the entire event. When the Protest Committee, from its own observation or a report received from any source believes that a competitor may have committed a breach of a rule, good manners, or sportsmanship, or may have brought the sport into disrepute, it may call a hearing. After a proper hearing the penalty may range from a reprimand to dismissal from the regatta and additional action may be taken under RRS 69.
- 11.3 Hearings related to 12.1 and 12.2 will be held generally in accordance with the recommendations of Appendix M5 of the RRS. The officers for hearing a violation will consist of the Chief Judge, acting as chairman of the hearing, the Protest Committee and the Chairman of the Texas Sailing Association Junior Committee or his or her designee in the event he or she is not present. The regatta chair shall serve ex officio as a nonvoting member of the panel and will have an open right to express his or her views during the course of the hearing process.
- **12. TROPHY PRESENTATION:** Trophy presentations will be held on Sunday afternoon approximately one hour after the last race or when protest hearing(s) are completed. The number of trophies will be determined by the number of entries in each fleet. Participation awards will be given to all Green Fleet competitors.
- **13. LODGING:** Camping is allowed on the DCYC premises. There is a limited number of RV spaces available at a first come/first served basis. DCYC has showers available.
- 14. DIRECTIONS TO THE CLUB: From I-35E traveling North from Dallas, take Exit 458 Swisher and turn right on Swisher. Continue about 2.6 miles over the Lake Lewisville Toll Bridge until you intersect with FM 720. Turn left on FM 720. Travel about 2 miles to McCormick (stoplight). Turn left on McCormick. Turn left at the first stop sign, Yacht Club Road. The club will be at the end of Yacht Club Road.
