NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The following racing rules will be changed in the sailing instructions: 28, 60.1(a), 61.1(b), 62.1(a), 62.2, 63.1(b), A4, A5, and Race Signals. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by Pensacola Yacht Club (PYC).

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the following classes: Fish, Thistle, Lightning, Viper 640, and VX-One.
- 3.2 Five boats are required to constitute a class.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing registration on line at Regatta Network (<http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.php>).

4 FEES

Required fees are \$75 for all classes.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 November 9, Saturday:

0830 - 1030	Registration at PYC
1030	Competitors meeting
1155	Warning signal for first race of the day
1700	Post race competitors party and dinner

November 10, Sunday:

0955	Warning Signal for the first race of the day
1600	Post-race competitors party with complimentary hors d'oeuvres
1600	Awards ceremony

5.2 Number of Races:

Thistle Class

- a) Five races are scheduled for the regatta.
- b) No warning signal will be made after 1230 on November 10, Sunday.

Fish, Lightning, Viper 640, and VX-One Classes

- a) The race committee will attempt to conduct as many races on each racing day as practicable.
- b) No warning signal will be made after 1330 on November 10, Sunday except as a consequence of a general recall.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on-line at Regatta Network after November 1 and on-site at PYC during registration November 9, Saturday, 0830 – 1030.

7 VENUE

The racing areas will be on Pensacola Bay south of the Bayou Chico channel entrance.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be stated in the sailing instructions.

9 SCORING

- 9.1** For the Thistle class, one race is required to be completed to constitute a series and no race scores shall be excluded from the series.
- 9.2** For the Fish, Lightning, Viper 640, and VX-One classes, one race is required to be completed to constitute a series and when five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be given for the regatta as follows: First to third place in each class of five or more boats.

11 DISCLAIMER OF RESPONSIBILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk – see RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per incident or the equivalent.

13 PHOTOGRAPHER AND VIDEO RIGHTS

By participating in this event, competitors grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio, or video recording, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
