

THE 2019 SAN PEDRO BAY CUP REGATTA

NOTICE OF RACE

RULES: The regatta shall be governed by the *RRS* and *PHRF*.

ELIGIBILITY: The regatta is open to all members of clubs of the Association of San Pedro Bay Yacht Clubs. The skipper and helms' person of each boat shall be a member in good standing of the yacht club he or she represents. All boats shall have current *PHRF* certificate and be equipped in accordance with the Class rules. All boats shall have a random leg rating of between 50 and 150

PROTEST COMMITTEE: Each participating club shall provide one qualified judge to serve on the Protest Committee. The Association shall designate the chief judge.

VENUE: Races will be sailed in the waters of San Pedro Bay. The start finish area will be .7 NM SE of the Cabrillo Marina entrance All shore side events will be held at Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club, the host club.

SCHEDULE OF RACES: One race is scheduled. The warning for the first race shall be at 1225 hours.

COMPETITOR'S BRIEFING: A competitor's briefing (Skippers Meeting) shall be held at 1000 hours on Saturday, October 5, 2019 at CBYC. This meeting is not mandatory, but highly recommended.

ENTRIES: Entries must be received at CBYC no later than September 28, 2019. Entries will be on line at Regatta Network: <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19791>
The Entry Fee is \$30.00.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSES: The sailing instruction/course chart will be posted on Regatta Network, at CBYC and any posted amendments. Competing yachts shall fly their Club Burgee from the backstay. There shall be no electronic communication, except between a competitor and the race committee once the starting sequence has commenced.

SCORING: Score shall be the Low Point system as stated in rules 90.3 and Appendix A. *PHRF* Area C random leg handicap shall be used.

PRIZES: The Club who team wins the race shall be awarded the San Pedro Bay Cup perpetual trophy. Trophies will be awarded to first three finishing yachts.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES: The hospitality of CBYC is extended to all competitors and guests. The bar at CBYC will be open on Friday and Saturday evenings. Food will be available on Friday and Saturday evening.

FACILITIES AND MOORING: CBYC is located at Berth 35 in the Cabrillo Marina, at 211 W. 22nd Street, San Pedro. Guest slips will be available, as well as trailer storage. A 6,000-pound capacity hoist is available. For reservations or information contact CBYC Dock Master; Dean Wyer at 310-519-1694.
