

NOTICE OF RACE

A day of competitive, yet casual racing featuring multiple Windward/leeward races with offset marks and gates, plus hot dogs and beer in the "Viper Pit" following racing.

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

- 2 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, & FEES
- The regatta is open to all boats belonging to the Viper Class.

- Registration will be on regatta network (<u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19793</u>) or morning of event.

- The entry fee is \$30 per boat if <u>received</u> by Sunday, October 13. After October 13, the fee is \$40.

3 SCHEDULE & RACING PROGRAM

- Check-In at 0900 in "Viper Pit". S.I.s available (plus on regatta network).

- Brief Skippers Meeting at 0945 in "Viper Pit".
- Warning is scheduled for 1100 near mooring ball off Hampton Flats.
- Multiple windward/leewards. Short races (target time = 40 mins).

- No race to be started after 1430.

- Hot dogs and beer in the "Viper Pit" following racing.

(Plus the awarding of the prestigious, coveted "Viper Day Trophy"!!)

- 4 COURSE
- Windward/leeward, twice around using offset marks and gates.

5 PENALTIES

- RRS V1 (Penalty at Time of Incident) is in effect.

6 SCORING

- Low Point System of Appendix A is modified to allow no throw-outs.

7 LAUNCHING & HAULING

- Free launching and hauling at HYC hoist.

- Hampton YC will provided area for storage of boats for teams wishing to return for the Hampton Fall Fling (Nov 2-3)

8 RADIOS

- RC will broadcast courtesy information plus OCS hails via VHF-72.

- Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority, Race Committee, or volunteers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
