1. RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all sailors. Only the driver must be female. Yacht Club membership is not required. Boats must have a PHRF certificate. There may be a spinnaker and a non spinnaker division.
- 2.2 Eligible boats can be entered by completing online registration at www.richmondyc.org.
- 2.3 Entry fee is \$50 per boat

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES

North and Central San Francisco Bay

6. SCORING

One race is scheduled.

7. ARBITRATION

Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.

8. DOCKAGE

Participants are invited to use RYC guest dock and dry storage facilities for the duration of the regatta. If you wish to extend your stay to the day before and/or the day after, you must coordinate with the harbormaster. (510)234-6959

9. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF radio to communicate information about time to start and OCS.

Prizes will be awarded to first place of each division. The trophy presentation and complimentary hors d'oeuvres will be held at the RYC bar after the racing on Nov. 3th
