

2019/2020 Chili Midwinter Series NOTICE OF RACE

November 3rd – December 1st – January 5th – February 2nd – March 1st

The Sausalito Yacht Club invites Bay Sailors to come out to the SYC Chili Midwinter Series. Races are held on the first Sunday of the month from November through March.

1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. Designated advertising Category A.

2. The regatta is open to all yachts with a valid 2019 PHRF certificate and members of one-design fleets. Boats without a PHRF Certificate may be assigned a rating at the discretion of the Race Committee. Five or more one-design entries may constitute a class. Sport Boat (displacement-to-length ratio of 112 or less **and** waterline length of 32 feet or less; i.e., D / $(2.24 \times (LWL / 10)^3) \le 112$ and LWL \le 32 where D is displacement in pounds and LWL is waterline length in feet) and Multi-hull classes are also welcomed. Sport boats and multi-hulls may be included in other divisions if they do not have a minimum of 5 entries.

3. There will be divisions for Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, and Double-Handed Non-Spinnaker.

4. Early entry helps the Race Committee create divisions that give the best competition. Entry fee is \$140 for the entire series before October 30th (\$160 thereafter) or \$40 for an individual race.

6. The Sailing Instructions will be posted online, and at the club on the club Race board by Friday, November 1st, at 1800hrs.

7. The intended racing area is the Knox/Yellow Bluff area of SF Bay using temporary and fixed mark courses.

8. The first warning signal for each race will be at 1200 hours.

9. The low point scoring system RRS A4 shall be used. "Time on time" scoring will be used for PHRF divisions. A minimum of one race shall be completed to constitute a series. If five races are completed, one will be excluded. The series shall be scored as a series longer than a regatta.

10. Prizes will be awarded to winners of individual races after each race. Series and Perpetual trophies will be awarded after the last race of the series.

Competitors may also enter by mail by filling out an entry form and submitting the appropriate fee. Entry forms are available at the club or by emailing, <u>race@sausalitoyachtclub.org</u>
