

Sunday November 24, 2019 Del Rey Yacht Club Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

This is an opportunity for DRYC members to compete against each other. Please join us for the traditional turkey prizes after the race!

1 RULES

- 1.1 This race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- **1.2** Spinnakers are not allowed inside Marina del Rey harbor. The head of any spinnaker must be below the lowest spreader, when the bow crosses an extension of the detached breakwater.
- **1.3** Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 1000 race day at dryc.org and on the DRYC Notice Board, located inside the clubhouse.
- **1.4** Verbal instructions may be given on the water. This changes *RRS* 90.2c.
- **1.5** This is an intra-club race and each entry must be skippered by a DRYC member.

2 ENTRY & RATINGS

- 2.1 Enter at dryc.org, under Racing. The entry deadline is 0900 race day. There is NO entry fee.
- **2.2** Valid PHRF of So. California W/L ratings will apply. Entries without one, will be assigned one by the R/C. This changes the Class rules and complies with *RRS* 87. Boats competing without a spinnaker, must submit their rating (including their Non-Spin offset) at time of entry.

3 CLASSES, CLASS FLAGS AND SCHEDULE

- **3.1** Divisions will be established for PHRF and Cruising.
- 3.2 If the R/C finds an entry unsuitable for the Cruising Division, that entry may be assigned to PHRF.
- **3.3** Class assignments/splits, flags and the order of starts will be posted at dryc.org and on the Notice Board, no later than 1000 race day.
- 3.4 There will be a *mandatory skippers meeting* for all entries in the bar area, at 0930 race day.
- **3.5** The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1155. Multiple sound signals will be made one minute before the first warning signal.

4. COURSES AND MARKS

The courses are described on page 2 of this document.

5 THE START

The Starting Line will be in the vicinity of S Mark and will be between a tetrahedron and an orange flag on the R/C boat.

6 THE FINISH

- **6.1** The Finishing Line will be between an orange flag on a boat in DRYC's main channel dock and an orange flag in the water.
- **6.2** Any boat not finishing by 1630 will be scored DNF (Did Not Finish) without a hearing. This changes *RRS* 35, A4 and A5.

7 COMMUNICATION

The RC will attempt to announce starting information and recalls on VHF 68.

8 PROTESTS

Protests shall be filed at DRYC's front desk within 30 minutes after finishing (Protest Time Limit).

9 SCORING

PHRF of So. Cal. W/L ratings shall apply.

10 HOSPITALITY & TROPHIES

Please join us in the clubhouse after the race, for appetizers, a no-host bar and turkey presentations.
