# NOTICE OF RACE

## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 The Sailing instructions may be modified verbally on the water. Racing Rules of Sailing Part 4 preamble will be changed as follows: When flag Y is displayed ashore, RRS 40 applies at all times while afloat. Racing rule A4.1 will be changed as follows: A boat starting later than four (4) minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. Racing rule 33 will be changed as follows: During the race, "gate" marks may be repositioned without signal for minor changes in course. Racing rule 33 (a) (2) will be changed as follows: The race committee will display a green rectangular board if the direction is changed to starboard or a red rectangular board if the direction is changed to port. Racing rules 35 and A4.1 will be changed as follows: Boats failing to finish within fifteen (15) minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish.

## **5 QUALIFICATION**

**5.1** To qualify for series awards, a boat must come to the starting line in at least 50% of the scheduled races that are completed.

The sailing instructions will be available before the scheduled start of Winter Series 1.

#### **8 VENUE**

Manasquan River west of the Route 35 Bridge.

#### **9 THE COURSES**

Windward/Leeward/Triangular/Around the Buoys courses.

#### 10 SCORING

- **10.1** The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. RRS A.9, Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta, replaces RRS A4.2.
- **10.2** The number of scheduled races is "multiple" of which 1 must be completed to constitute the series.
- **10.4** The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply as changed below. RRS A2 is changed so one (1) race will be excluded for every five (5) races completed.
- **10.5** Points shall be awarded to a boat and may not be transferred except by specific written permission of the Regatta Committee.
- **10.6** No race shall be declared official unless three or more entrants come to the starting line.

## 11 BERTHING

Boat Storageis available free of charge, to those intending at least 50% of the races. Skippers intending to store their boat at MRYC during the series should notify MRYC's

## 12 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats..

## 13 REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT

**Notes:** 1. Manual bailer must be a minimum of 4-quart capacity.

2. All boats must carry a readily available line solely dedicated to towing or anchoring and for use at all times, 24' long and able to tow a swamped boat.

#### 14 AWARDS

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other

organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

## 16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of the policy limit of their homeowner's insurance policy per event or the equivalent thereof.
