



**Race 4 – Cat Harbor Layover  
June 6, 2020  
Sailing Instructions**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 This race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 USSA Prescriptions RRS 63.2 thru 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.3 RRS 82 will not apply.

**2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Notice Board inside the DRYC clubhouse and at DRYC.org. Any amendments to these sailing instructions will be posted by 0830 race day.

**3 SCHEDULE, CLASSES AND CLASS FLAGS**

- 3.1 Class flags and the order of starts are posted on the DRYC Notice Board and at DRYC.org.
- 3.2 All boats are required to check in with the Race Committee (RC) boat no later than **1045** while the L flag is flying, or until the L flag is removed, whichever is later. Boats that do not check in by then will be assessed a 15% scoring penalty. Please **do not** attempt to check in via VHF.
- 3.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is **1055**, with multiple sounds made just before.

**4 COURSES AND MARKS**

- 4.1 From the starting line sail the course signaled by the RC (code flag A or B):

**Course A** (36.5nm) - Leave the El Segundo bell buoy (2ES) and the West End of Catalina Island to port. Proceed to **THE FINISH SI 6.1**.

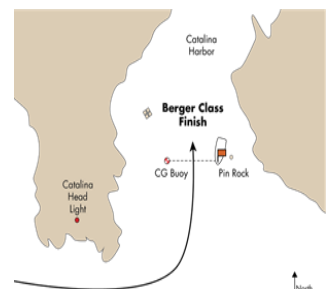
**Course B** (29.2nm) - Leave the El Segundo bell buoy (2ES) to port. Proceed to **THE FINISH SI 6.3**.

**5 THE START**

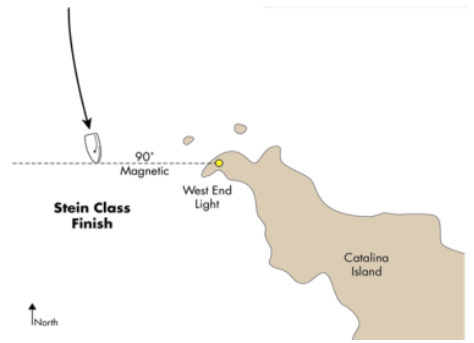
- 5.1 The starting area will be in the vicinity of MDR H Mark (see MDR Course Chart 17).
- 5.2 The starting line will be between an orange inflatable mark and an orange flag on the RC boat.

**6 THE FINISH**

- 6.1 **Berger Division-** The finishing line will be between the Coast Guard buoy and an orange flag on the RC boat (see diagram). Boats finishing after 1930 shall illuminate their sail number.
- 6.2 The RC intends to be on station until 2000. If the RC is not on station, record your finish time (GPS) when your bow crosses the line between the Coast Guard buoy and Pin Rock. When crossing the finishing line, Pin Rock will bear 70m and the CG buoy will bear 250m. Proceed to **SI 6.5**.



**6.3 Stein Division**-The finishing line begins at the West End Catalina Island Light, extending 1/2 nm on a bearing of 270°m (see diagram). When the light bears 90°m from your bow, record your finish time and take a “Screen shot(s)” of your GPS including your lat, lon, distance from the West End Light and finish time. Submit your screen shots to [racers@dryc.org](mailto:racers@dryc.org), no later than 1200 Monday after the race, use your sail number as the subject [DP].



**6.4 All boats** must complete and submit Attachment B to the RC (near the galley) ASAP, but no later than 0900 the day after the race [DP].

**6.5** Boats not finishing by 2230 (Time Limit) will be scored DNF and shall comply with **SI 6.4** (this changes RRS 35, 63.1 and A5).

**7 HANDICAP RATINGS**

PHRF California Area B RLC ratings will apply. Standard production boats from outside of Area B may have Area B ratings applied.

**8 PROTESTS**

**8.1** Boats intending to protest shall notify the RC of their intention to protest within 1 hour of finishing, via VHF channel 68, the race Finish PRO’s phone number (see **SI 12**) or in person.

**8.2** Protests (forms available at the DRYC front desk) shall be filed at the DRYC front desk no later than 1200 Monday June 8 (Protest Time Limit). Hearings will be scheduled for a later date.

**9 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

The RC may announce starting information on VHF channel 68 (RRS 62.1 will not apply).

**10 PRIZES**

There trophy presentation for this race will take place on June 27, 2020 (see **NOR 7.1**).

**11 DISCLAIMER**

Competitors participate in these races entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4). By participating in these races, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors and any others acting in any official capacity for these races) from any and all liability associated with such competitor’s participation in this event, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
