

Race 5 – Eagle Rock to Marina del Rey June 7, 2020 Sailing Instructions

1 RULES

- 1.1 This race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- **1.2** USSA Prescriptions RRS 63.2 thru 63.4 will not apply.
- **1.3** RRS 82 will not apply.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Notice Board near the galley and if possible, at dryc.org. Any amendments to these sailing instructions will be posted by 0900 race day.

3 SCHEDULE, CLASSES AND CLASS FLAGS

- 3.1 Class flags and the order of starts are posted on the DRYC Notice Board and at DRYC.org.
- **3.2** All boats are required to check in with the Race Committee (RC) boat no later than 1145 while the L flag is flying or until the L flag is removed, whichever is later. Boats that do not check in will be assessed a 15% scoring penalty. Please **do not** attempt to check in via VHF.
- **3.3** The scheduled time of the first warning signal is **1155**, with multiple sounds made just before. CLEAR THE STARTING AREA, UNLESS YOU ARE IN YOUR STARTING SEQUENCE.

4 COURSES AND MARKS

4.1 From the starting line sail the course:

Course (29.7nm) - Leave the El Segundo bell buoy (2ES) to starboard. Proceed to SI 4.2.

4.2 Round the inflatable offset mark at approximately 33° 57.352'N 118° 27.582'W, leaving it to port. The R/C will attempt to have a strobe on this mark. Proceed to **THE FINISH SI 6.1** (see diagram).

5 THE START

- 5.1 The starting area will be in the vicinity of the West End of Santa Catalina Island.
- **5.2** The starting line will be between an orange flag on the RC boat and the summit of Eagle Rock.

6. THE FINISH

- **6.1** The finishing line will be between an orange flag on the RC boat and the green light on the south end of the Marina Del Rey detached breakwater.
- **6.2** The RC intends to be on station until 1900. If the RC boat is not on station, record your finish time (GPS) when the green light on the detached breakwater bears 200°m from your bow.
- **6.3** All boats must complete and submit Attachment B to the DRYC Front Desk no later than 1200 the day after the race. Out of area boats may submit to <u>racers@dryc.org</u>, using your sail number as the subject [DP].
- 6.4 Boats not finishing by 2230 (Time Limit) will be scored DNF and shall comply with SI 6.3 (this changes RRS 35, 63 and A5).

7 HANDICAP RATINGS

PHRF of So. California Area B OWC ratings will apply. Standard production boats from outside of Area B may have Area B ratings applied.

8 PROTESTS

- **8.1** Boats shall notify the RC of their intention to protest within one hour of finishing, via VHF channel 68, the Event Chairman's phone number (see **SI 12**) or by filing at DRYC's front desk.
- **8.2** Protests (forms available at the DRYC front desk) shall be filed at the DRYC front desk no later than 1200 the day after the race (Protest Time Limit). Hearings will be scheduled for a later date.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The RC may announce starting information on VHF channel 68 (RRS 62.1 will not apply).

10 PRIZES

11 There trophy presentation for this race will take place on June 27, 2020 (see NOR 7.1).

12 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in these races entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4). By participating in these races, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors and any others acting in any official capacity for these races) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event, to the fullest extent permitted by law.


