

## NOTICE OF RACE 34<sup>th</sup> Annual Ice Bucket Regatta

January 1, 2020 (alternate date Saturday, January 4, 2020)

The Ice Bucket Regatta is hosted by Lake Norman Yacht Club, 297 Yacht Rd., Mooresville, North Carolina 28117 (www.lnyc.org)

- 1. RULES: The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is open to PHRF-rated keelboats with a valid LNKC (<u>Lake Norman Keelboat Council</u>) certificate, and centerboard boats with a Portsmouth rating. A minimum of three boats shall constitute a class. Divisions within each fleet may be made at the discretion of the regatta committee.
- ENTRY: Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration form at Regatta Network
   (<a href="https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20057">https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20057</a>). (<a href="Please register prior to coming to the Club">Please register prior to coming to the Club</a>; this will save time, waiting for the use of a computer.) Payment can be made online, or at Late Registration and Check-in. Entry is not complete until payment is received.
- 4. FEES: Entry Fee: \$35.00 per boatLate Fee (after December 31): \$5.00US Sailing Members are discounted \$5.00

- 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Available at check-In.
- 7. RACING AREA: The racing area will be on Lake Norman in close proximity to the Lake Norman Yacht Club.
- 8. THE Courses: The courses to be sailed will be a combination of permanent lake marks and temporary marks, and will be described in the Sailing Instructions.
- SCORING: All boats will be scored using PHRF Time on Distance, pursuit format. Low Point System; Appendix A2 of the
  racing rules will apply, except that all races will be scored with no throw outs. This changes RRS A2. Two races are
  scheduled. One race completed shall constitute a regatta.
- 10. PRIZES: Perpetual trophies (Ice Bucket Overall, Dinghy Overall Ice Bucket and class Ice Buckets) will be presented to the top scoring finishers. In addition, prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries in a class, as follows: 3 to 5 boats 2 trophies; 6 to 8 boats 3 trophies; 9 or more boats 4 trophies.
- 11. FURTHER INFORMATION:

**Soup Competition:** To enter, bring **homemade soup** (at least 8 servings). Chili not eligible for prizes. Please notify Treez in advance, with what soup you are bringing.
