NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority for the 2020 Naples Sabot Senior Class Championship will be the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club (ABYC), 7201 East Ocean Blvd, Long Beach, CA. 90803 in conjunction with the International Naples Sabot Association (INSA).

The notation '[DPJ]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. RRS 44.1 will be changed such that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced with a One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.3. RRS 26 will be changed as follows: Warning signal will be given three (3) minutes before the starting signal. The Preparatory signal will be given two (2) minutes before the Starting signal.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Naples Sabot Class declared eligible by INSA, who hold a 2020 INSA membership and have a 2020 transom sticker. All boats must have a valid measurement certificate or be listed as a measured boat in the most current INSA Yearbook.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.abyc.org, paying the entry fee, and completing measurement.
- 2.3. Late entries will be accepted until Saturday, June 6, 2020 at 10:30 am.
- 2.4. Divisions for the regatta are: Seniors, Masters, Grand Masters and Clydesdale classes, which will race separately.
 - a) Senior class competitors must be 18 years old or older by the first day of the regatta.
 - b) Masters class competitors must be 40 years old or older by the first day of the regatta. The Masters Division will also be split into Gold and Silver Flights self designated by the



Skipper at the time of registration and subject to review by the Fleet Captains prior to the first race.

- c) Grand Masters class competitors must be 65 years old or older by the first day of the regatta.
 - d) Clydesdale class competitors must be 18 years old or older by the first day of the regatta. Competitor weight of 220 pounds is required. Minimum competitor weight is 200 pounds with additional weights carried to reach the 220-pound requirement.
 - e) To constitute a fleet or division, each fleet or division shall have a minimum of three (3) entries. The PRO may combine the starts of fleets with less than five (5) entries. Scoring will be separate.
- 2.5. There are no restrictions on the number of boats entering the regatta.
- 2.6. Competitors must check-in at Registration.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Registration:

4.2. Competitors Meeting:

Saturday June 6, 2020 1030

4.3. Dates of Racing:

Saturday June 6, 2020 Warning Signal for 1st race of day. 1200
Sunday June 7, 2020 Warning Signal for 1st race of day. 1200

4.4. Prize giving for the Grand Master division will occur following Saturday's races. The Grand Master Division will NOT sail on Sunday

4.5. Prize giving for the Senior, Master and Clydesdale divisions will occur following Sunday's races.



5. MEASUREMENTS

- 5.1. All boat and sail measurement should be completed at prior local fleet measurement dates to be determined by local fleets.
- 5.2. Equipment can be measured at ABYC on Friday, June 5 from 1500 - 1800. Measurement of equipment on Saturday, June 6, will be available from 0830-1030
- 5.3. No entry will be complete until the INSA Measurement Form is completed, signed by the appropriate fleet measurer, and received by the Organizing Authority.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club website <http://www.abyc.org> by Friday, May 15, 2020 and at check-in.

7. VENUE

- 7.1. ABYC is located on Alamitos Bay, which is situated in the South Eastern part of Long Beach California.
- 7.2. The races will be held in the enclosed waters of Alamitos Bay.

8. THE COURSES

Courses will be a windward leeward or triangle windward leeward.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. Senior, Master and Clydesdale Championship Series: Six (6) races are scheduled of which three (3) must be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2. Grand Master Championship Series: Three (3) races are scheduled of which one (1) must be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores. When six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores, excluding her worst score.

10. PENALTIES

The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 will be a One-Turn Penalty, this changes Rule 44.1.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1. Prizes will be given as follows:
 - a) Senior and Master Gold Classes – First through fifth take home
 - b) Master Silver, Grand Master and Clydesdale Classes - First take home
 - c) Daily First trophies for winners of each race for all fleets.



11.2. Perpetual Trophies

- a) Senior National Championship Perpetual – Awarded to the winner of the Senior Fleet.
- b) Edward Gaudio Memorial Perpetual – Awarded to the winner of the Masters Fleet.
- c) Grand Masters Perpetual – Awarded to the winner of the Grand Masters Fleet.
- d) Clydesdale Perpetual – Awarded to the winner of the Clydesdale Division.
