





NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 2020 LNKC ICICLE SERIES

January 11, 18, February 1, February 8 (Make up), February 15 (Awards)

The organizing authority is the Lake Norman Keelboat Council and Lake Norman Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and the Lake Norman Keelboat Council's Lakewide Sailing Instructions, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- The US Sailing Prescriptions of Appendix V (Alternative Procedures for Dispute Resolution) Rules V1 and V2 will be in effect.
- 1.3. 3.2 changes LSI 9.1, 9.2 and RRS 63.1 and A5.
- 1.4. 8.1 changes LSI 10.3.
- 1.5. 10.1 changes LSI 10.1 as follows: There will be two starts; the first start will be for the Sport Boat and Traditional Spinnaker Classes, and the second start will be for the non-Spinnaker Class.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. This is a LNKC Lakewide event. The Lakewide Sailing Instructions apply.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter the regatta by registering and paying applicable fees online at
- 2.3. Entrants may register for one of three classes: Sport Boat, Traditional Spinnaker or Non-Spinnaker. The Classes may be further divided into Divisions.

3. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. On the water changes to the sailing instructions may be made from 0 to 10 minutes before the Warning Signal of any race. Code flag 'Lima' will be displayed and the announcement of the change made on VHF Channel 69.
- 3.2. Prior to the first warning signal of her first race of each day, each boat is required to check in by passing astern of the race committee signal boat on starboard tack and hail her sail number until acknowledged by the race committee. Failure to check-in prior to the first race each day shall result in a 20% scoring penalty without a hearing for that race. Code Flag #3 will not be used for check-in. This changes LSI 9.1, 9.2 and RRS 63.1 and A5.
- 3.3. Both Sport Boat and Traditional Spinnaker Classes will use Code Flag 1 for course designation, as well as starting.

4. ENTRY

- 4.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration form at Regatta Network (http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20108).
- 4.2. Payment must be made online.
- 4.3. Entry is not complete until payment is received.

5. **FEES**:

Entry Fee: \$40.00 per boat

Late Fee (after January 5th): \$5.00 US Sailing Members are discounted \$5.00

6. SCHEDULE

6.1. There will be two races on each race date. There will be one make-up day with a maximum of two races. The Warning Signal for the first race of any day will be at 10:25 AM. There will be no Competitors meeting (Please direct questions to Tim Porter (porter.timothym@gmail.com 571-432-7152).

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. Except as modified by this NOR/SI, the Lakewide Sailing Instructions apply.

8. RACING AREA

8.1. The starting area will be in the vicinity of channel marker D3. The specific location of the start will be at the discretion of the Race Committee. This changes LSI 10.3. 11.2.

9. THE COURSES

9.1. The Lakewide Sailing Instructions apply.

10. THE START

10.1. There will be two starts; the first start will be for the Sport Boat and Traditional Spinnaker Classes (Code Flag 1), and the second start will be for the non-Spinnaker Class (Code Flag 2). This changes LSI 10.1.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. The Time on Time Low Point Scoring System A2 shall apply.
- 11.2. Each boat's best four (4) scores will count toward her Series score.

12. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 12.1. Participants are encouraged to resolve any protests on the water according to the RRS.
- 12.2. Protest instructions are included in the LSI.

13. PRIZES

- 13.1. If more than 4 boats are entered in a division, one trophy will be awarded for first and second place in that Class or Division.
- 13.2. If less than 4 boats are entered in a division, one trophy will be awarded for first place in that Class or Division.

14. FURTHER INFORMATION

- 14.1. A race day will be canceled if at 8:00 PM on the day prior to the race, the high temperature for the day of the race is forecast to be below 40 degrees. The forecast to be used will be that for Cornelius, NC posted on Weather Channel found at https://weather.com/weather/today/I/USNC0157:1:US
- 14.2. In the event of a cancellation registrants will be notified by email and/or text.
