1. RULES:

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- The rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR) will apply.
- The amendment to STCR 31.2.6 (ISCYRA Resolution #4-2016) is in effect: Boats may carry VHF radios for purposes of safety and for receiving race committee communication, including notification of OCS boats.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: All members in good standing with ISCYRA are eligible.

- 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be provided at Registration. They may be posted at www.milesriveryc.org when available.
- RACING AREA: The race area will be Miles River. If conditions dictate otherwise, racing may be held in Eastern Bay.
 Announcement of the race area will be made at the Skipper's meeting.
- 8. SCORING: The low point scoring system of Appendix A (RRS) shall apply. One completed race constitutes a series. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race

scores unless (4) four or more races are completed and then she may exclude her worst score.

9. TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded to the first, second, and third finishers. The winner is awarded the Dr. DAVID OURSLER MEMORIAL TROPHY. The Awards ceremony is scheduled at 3:00 pm on Sunday following the racing.

Green Star: The MRYC Spring Regatta will be the 2020 Green star event for District 2. Please identify yourself to the race committee as a Novice Skipper per Star Class Rule 23.7.1.

Rule 23.7.1: "A Novice Skipper is one who has never as a skipper won any series honor that is higher than a Green event honor, or as a skipper won a Green event."

- **10. LAUNCHING** AND **BERTHING**: Lift launching and dry storage are available. Washing/cleaning of boats must only be done in the Club field.
- 11. SOCIAL:
 - BREAKFAST: A continental breakfast will be served Saturday & Sunday and is included in the registration fee.
