NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

This event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020* ("RRS") including *US Sailing Prescriptions*.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This event is open to all single hull boats holding a valid PHRF certification issued by the *Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound* (YRALIS) (www.yralis.org). No club affiliation is required. Provisional ratings may be obtained for this event by contacting the PJYC Fleet Measurer, Mort Fortgang at: sailor36@optimum.net.

Eligible boats shall enter by registering online using www.RegattaNetwork.com. Entries must be received no later than September 18th. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Fleet Captain.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available no later than 1900 on September 13, 2020 at portjeffersonyachtclub.com and through RegattaNetwork.

ENTRIES

Eligible Yachts must be entered by completing the online registration form at [RegattaNetwork](#). No mail ins will be accepted.

VENUE

Start area- Centered approximately 1.0 NM NE of the Port Jefferson Harbour East Breakwater. Race will be across Long Island Sound to a buoy or buoys off the Bridgeport/Stratford Connecticut coast. See the Sailing Instructions for more detail.

DIVISIONS

The fleet may be divided into Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker divisions. Scratch Sheets will be available on-line prior to the race at [portjeffersonyachtclub.com](#) and through [RegattaNetwork](#).

THE COURSE

This is a distance race, starting at a line from the club's 'SF' mark to the Committee Boat, then crossing Long Island Sound to buoy(s) (TBA) just off the Bridgeport/Stratford shores, and back to the Port Jefferson Harbor Entrance. Distance will be between 20 and 25 NM. Courses will be signalled from the Committee Boat in accordance with the *Sailing Instructions*.

SCORING

- All divisions except any 'One Designs' will use YRALIS PHRF ratings and will be scored Time-on-Distance.
- Scoring for this event will use the 'Low Point' system as describes in the RRS Rule 90.3 and RRS Appendix A.
