



NOTICE OF RACE

Harry Wood Memorial Regatta

Balboa Yacht Club

Sunday March 15, 2020



The Organizing Authority (OA) for this event is Balboa Yacht Club, which is located at 1801 Bayside Drive, Corona Del Mar, CA 92625 and at www.balboayachtclub.com on the Internet.

1) RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, which automatically include the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association.

2) ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- This regatta is open to boats of the Lido 14 class whose registered skipper is a current member of the Lido 14 Class Association or is a guest of Lido 14 Fleet 1 (Newport Beach, CA).
- The registered skipper shall be a current member of a yacht club or sailing organization recognized by US Sailing.
- Lido 14 A and Lido 14 B divisions are offered.
- Entry is available online at www.balboayachtclub.com. Click on the "On the Water" top menu item and then the "Online Registration" sub menu item to see a list of BYC events - where you will find the Harry Wood Memorial Regatta listed.
- The entry fee is \$20.00 per boat and is payable with a credit card or PayPal funds. BYC members will also be allowed to charge their entry to their account. The entry fee provides a commemorative Harry Wood Memorial regatta shirt for the skipper and crew (first come, first served – as supplies last).
- The entry period closes at 11:30AM on March 15, 2020.

3) SCHEDULE

4) VENUE & COURSES

- Races will be sailed on the waters of Newport Harbor in the vicinity of the BYC clubhouse.
- All on shore activities (e.g. Competitor Check-In, Competitors Meeting, protest related events, Awards presentation) will be at the flag deck level of Balboa Yacht Club (BYC).
- Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions, marks will be movable inflatable buoys.

5) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions and course charts will be available online at the event webpage on www.balboayachtclub.com. Hardcopy versions will be available at the Competitor Check-In on the day of the regatta.

6) SCORING

- The RRS Low Point Scoring System shall apply except that a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.
- Three (3) completed races shall constitute a series.

7) FACILITIES

The hospitality of BYC and its facilities, except on-site automobile parking, are extended to all competitors. On-site trailer parking is provided. Boats are launched at BYC via an electric hoist; boats must be equipped with an internal lifting sling.

8) AWARDS

Take home awards and perpetual trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew for the top three (3) boats in both the A and B divisions and to the highest ranking skipper over the age of 60.

9) RELEASE

- a) By entering into this regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if the competitor is under the age of 18) grants to the OA and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.
- b) A registered skipper not yet eighteen (18) years of age on the date of this event must have their parent/guardian submit a completed parental release form to Balboa Yacht Club's Sailing Director prior to the close of Competitor Check-In). If said skipper's crew is also not yet eighteen (18) years of age they will need to fill out a form as well. Release forms will be available at Competitor Check in.
