NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Changes to the rules and national prescriptions that apply will be designated in the Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The series is open to all experienced sailors.
- 2.2 The primary boat sailed will be the ILCA Dinghy.
- 2.3 Other dinghy classes such as Optimists and 420s are eligible to participate provided that a minimum of three boats are sailing on any given race night.
- 2.4 Eligible sailors may enter online at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20484>. Registration is required for all sailors and crew.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The following fees must be paid online at the time of registration:
Junior Entry (Under 19 on June 18, 2020): \$60. Includes the use of a boat provided by AHSEP or storage of a sailor owned boat in the AHSEP storage area.
Adult Entry (Over 19 on June 18, 2020): \$90. Boat storage is not included.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The series will take place each Thursday.
- 4.2 On each race day, every effort will be made to complete 4 races. However, more than or fewer than 4 races may be sailed.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1830.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The sailing instructions are available at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20484>.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The venue is Sandy Hook Bay.
- 6.3 For adult sailors, storage can be arranged with the Sandy Hook Bay Catamaran club or boats can be launched from the Avenue A beach in Atlantic Highlands. Street parking is available there.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The scoring system will be a High Point Percentage Scoring system detailed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.2 A competitor must complete 60% of the races sailed in order to be scored in the series.

8 AWARDS

- 8.1 Awards will be presented at the AHSEP Barbeque on August 13 at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
