May 14 – September 17, 2020 NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: South Haven Yacht Club

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2. The following US Sailing Prescriptions will not apply: 63.2, 63.4.

1.3. Appendix V will apply. The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: "A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing or rule 31."

1.4. Any additions or changes will be posted on the Official Notice Board (located in the dining room of the SHYC).

2. ADVERTISING

1. No restrictions.

2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The series is open to PHRF boats with a valid 2020 LM-PHRF rating certificate. The series is also open to One Design boats for competition in separate sections without the requirement of a valid LM-PHRF rating certificate if four or more entries are received and four or more are present for racing at commencement of Registration. One Design boats in One Design Classes failing to meet the minimum number of entries may race in an assigned PHRF section so long as they present a valid 2020 LM-PHRF rating certificate at Registration.

3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form, Release/Waiver together with the required fee in Regatta Network or by sending it to South Haven Yacht Club. Early entries may pay lower fees as set forth on the entry form.

3.3. Deadline: Entry forms and fees must be received at SHYC no later than 0900 EDT on May , 2020.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Registration will be prior to May 13, 2020 at 0900 EDT at SHYC.

4.2. Skippers Meeting will be Thursday, May , 7 2020 at 1800 EDT at SHYC Dining Room.

4.3. The warning signal for the first race each Thursday is scheduled for 1900 EDT.

4.4. It is the intent of the Race Committee to conduct one complete race each Thursday. The number of races is subject to weather conditions. No initial Warning Signal for the starting sequence will be made after 2030 on Thursday.

4.5. Subsequent races will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race.5. MEASUREMENTS

 Each boat racing on a handicap basis shall produce a valid 2020 LM-PHRF Rating Certificate. There is no provision for assignment of ratings to boats without certificates.
Each boat racing in a One Design section shall produce a valid One-Design measurement certificate.

3. Crew weigh-ins for One Design fleets, if required by fleet rules, will be conducted by each One Design fleet requiring crew weigh-ins.

6. SECTION BREAKS

6.1. LM-PHRF section breaks and One Design sections will be available at Registration. Handicaps will be scored using the "Time on Distance" adjustments.

6.2. Sections and starting order: SPIN to start first and JAM to start second each Thursday.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skipper Meeting and via email.

8. THE COURSES AND RACING AREA

8.1. The course areas will be in the open waters of Lake Michigan with the starting areas offshore from the South Haven Pier Head. Multiple race courses may be established by the Organizing Authority to suit individual fleet requirements.

9. COURSES

9.1. Courses will be windward leeward for spinnaker classes and triangular for jib-and-main classes as described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PROTESTS

10.1. Protest Committee will have final authority in resolving conflicts of eligibility and/or compliance with entry requirements. This changes rule 66.

11. SCORING

11.1. The Low Point System of Appendix A of the racing rules will apply. Each yacht's score shall be the sum of all her races. There shall be one throw out for every 5 races. This amends rule A2. PHRF fleet shall race using corrected time on time. One race constitute a series.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

12.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions nor receive radio communications not available to all boats while racing. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and other mobile data devices.

13. AWARDS

13.1. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each section.

14. MEDIA AND MEDIA RIGHTS/RESTRICTIONS

14.1. By entering this regatta, the owner (or charterer) and crew members of the competing yacht grant, at no cost to SHYC, event sponsors and their respective officers, employees, volunteers and members the absolute right and permission to use their name, voice, image, likeness, biographical material as well as representations of the yachts in any media (being television, print and internet media, including video footage); for the sole purposes of advertising, promoting, reporting and disseminating information regarding the regatta, boats, event, or sport.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Specific attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 4, which states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue

racing is hers alone." 16. INSURANCE

16.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

17. AMENDMENTS TO THIS NOTICE

17.1 The Organizing Authority reserves the right to amend this Notice. Any amendment will be posted on the Official Notice Board and copies will be available at Registration.
