

2020 SPRING ONE DESIGN SERIES APRIL 18th, May 16th and June 20th 2020

1 Rule

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The series will be governed by the class rules of the individual classes.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Boats of the Santana 22, Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 One-Design classes are eligible to participate in this series. All other one-design classes may petition to participate prior to 1100 hours on Thursday, April 16th, 2020.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at <u>scyc.org/racing</u>. Only on-line entries will be accepted.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$105.00 and is applicable if entry is competed by 2000 hour on Wednesday April 15th, 2020.
- 3.2 The late entry fee of \$125.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Wednesday April 15th, 2020.
- 3.3 Registration for the series closes at 10:00 on April 18th.
- 3.4 The one-day entry fee is \$40.00. One day entries will not be scored in the series and must be received by 1000 hour on the day of racing.
- 3.5 Registration closes at 1000 hours on Saturday, June 20th, 2020.
- 3.6 All entry fees are nonrefundable.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting is scheduled for 1100 hours on Saturday, April 18, 2020 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day
- 4.3 For the Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 classes, nine races (9) are scheduled for the series with three (3) races each race day.
- 4.4 For the Santana 22 class, six (6) races are scheduled for the series with two (2) races each race day.
- 4.5 For all classes 4 races will constitute a series.
- 4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse on Saturday, June 20th, 2020 following racing.

5 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and on line at scyc.org.

6 Venue

6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

7.1 A course diagram will be provided in the sailing instructions.

8 Scoring

When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score. "This changes RRS Appendix A2.1"


9 **Prizes**
