Notice of Series

The Organizing Authority, Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club, 13589 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, is pleased to host the 2020 edition of Vic's BBQ Series. This series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* and is open to skippers who belong to an organization or club recognized by US Sailing.

Register online at Regatta Network no later than 1245 hours the day of the race. The entry fee is \$15.00 per race or \$60.00 for the entire series.

There will be three Classes will be based on PHRF Area B RLC base rating. A Class will be for boats rated 120 and under, B Class for boats rated 121-199 and C Class for boats rated 200 and over.

When registering for their first race of the Series, competitors will use their PHRF Area B RLC base rating. Ratings will be adjusted after each race based upon the results. Rating changes for A Class competitors shall not exceed 15 seconds per mile per adjustment.

The schedule consists of five races starting at 13:00 with the first warning at 12:55 on the following dates:

#1 – Sunday April 19, 2020
#2 – Saturday May 16, 2020
#3 – Sunday June 14, 2020
#4 – Sunday July 19, 2020
#5 – Sunday August 16, 2020 "The Great Circle"

Sailing instructions will be prepared for each race and will be available on Regatta Network and at SMWYC clubhouse no later than 900 hours on race days. The Sailing Instructions will describe each race's Random Leg courses and may include specific changes to the *RRS* and this Notice of Series. The Series will be scored using the High-point scoring system.

After each race there will be a racers recap in the bar area at SMWYC. Trophies will be presented at SMWYC after each race and Perpetual Series trophies will be presented to the overall winners during the SMWYC Awards night in the fall. Sailors who run a barbeque during the race will receive special awards. Come join in the fun!
