



# NOTICE OF RACE

# As amended 7/14/20 to incorporate the changes of Amendment #1

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, 2017 2020 (RRS).
- 1.2 All boats shall be in compliance with their respective class rules.

### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats in the following one-design classes: Star, Penguin, Comet, Adult Laser, Adult Laser Radial, Albacore.
- 2.2 Eligible boats must register by going to the TAYC website (<a href="www.tayc.com/racing">www.tayc.com/racing</a>) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 1600 Friday, July 31. On-line registration is required.
- 2.3 Bag lunches will be available for \$8/each, but must be ordered and paid for at registration. Lunches can be picked up at the Galley Window on race day.
- 2.4 Races may be cancelled for any class listed above if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by 1600 on Friday, July 31.
- 2.5 **All regatta participants**, including skippers and crew,**must**individually sign and electronically submit the Covid-19 waiver found at www.tayc.com/racing beforehand.

### 3 FEES

3.1 The entry fee is \$25. Fee to be received no later than 1600 Friday, July 31.

### 4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Clubhouse: As a result of the pandemic, there will be no food, bar or social activities at TAYC. The Clubhouse will be locked, but restrooms will be accessible from the outside. Bottled water will be available to the competitors at the Galley Window for \$1/bottle.
- 4.2 There will be no Competitors' meeting. Any notices will be posted electronically at www.tayc.com/racing.
- 4.3 As many races will be held as conditions permit. There will be an on-water lunch break. There will be no warning signals either day after **1600**.
- 4.4Warning signal for the first start for the Star class will be 1055 on Saturday, August 8. 4.5Warning signal for first start for all classes will be 1025 on Sunday, August 9.

#### 5 LAUNCHING

- 5.1 Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers must be stored in designated areas clear of hoist and access lanes.
- To avoid lift congestion on Sunday morning, Star class boats shall remain in the water at TAYC docks on Saturday night.
- 5.3 Social distancing and face masks are required for all individuals while on Club property.
- 5.4 Vehicles may not park on Club property; once boats/trailers are unloaded, they must exit.
- 5.5 No spectators or spectator boats will be allowed on Club property.

### **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website by 1600 on July 31 and will contain special Covid-19 related racing rule changes.

#### 7 THE VENUE

- 7.1 The Star class courses Saturday and Sunday will use drop marks in the Choptank River south/southwest of Choptank Light in the area designated course **Charlie**.
- 7.2 On Sunday, the centerboard classes will use drop marks in the Tred Avon River in the general area designated course **Foxtrot**, south of TAYC between Pier St. and Bachelor Pt.

#### **8 SAFETY REGULATIONS**

- 8.1 A boat that retires or leaves the racing area between races shall notify the Race Committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 8.2 Competitors are strongly encouraged to wear a USCG approved PFD while racing.

# 9 SCORING

9.1 One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

#### 10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 finishers, 2 if 5 finishers, 3 if 7 or more finishers.
- 10.2 Certain perpetual trophies may also be awarded in some classes.
- 10.3 There will be no award ceremony. Prizes will be mailed to winners.
- 10.4 Results will be posted at <a href="https://www.tayc.com/racing">www.tayc.com/racing</a>.

# 11 SPECIAL COVID-19 REGATTA RULES

- 11.1 Social distancing as prescribed by the CDC shall be practiced at all times while on Club property.
- 11.2 Masks covering the nose and mouth shall be worn by all individuals while on Club property.
- 11.3 Current state requirements for protection against the transmission of Covid-19 must be practiced throughout the regatta.
- 11.4 Non-crew members, except when helping to off-load or load boats, will not be allowed on Club property. Coaches and race officials are excepted.

## 12 Disclaimer of Liability

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or

personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
