Notice of Race

- 1. RULES: The races will be governed by the "Racing Rules of Sailing "2017 2020" the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, except as any of these are changed by the sailing instructions. All single-handed sailors shall wear a life jacket at all times. Handicapping will be done using the PHRF system based upon handicaps determined by the BBYC Handicap Committee.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY: The series is open to yachts of BBYC members or their guests. Eligible yachts may enter by completing registration online at www.regattanetwork.com/event/20818 and signing the helmspersons full name and sail number on the Check In sheet in the clubhouse 1/4 hour before the warning signal. Eligible competitors shall have a current handicap measurement form on file. Only BBYC members are eligible for season trophies. There is no entry fee.
- **3. SCHEDULE:** One race per day is scheduled. For races abandoned due to inclement weather or wind speeds over 16 knots, a notice will be posted on of the door of the club.
- 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available at Check In before each race and are linked online.
- 5. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS will be posted on the official notice board located inside the yacht club. Any change will be posted 30 minutes before the start of the race in which it will take effect, and shall be posted only by the race committee chairperson or officer of the club.
- **6. COURSES** will be signaled from the crow's nest with color coded letters identifying the direction and order of marks to be rounded. A BBYC mark sheet is available at Check In and is online.

7. SCORING:

- **7.1** The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the racing rules will apply.
- 7.2 No series score will be calculated for any yacht not registered, or any yacht not displaying proper sail numbers.
- **7.3** APPENDIX A 9 Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta will apply.
- **8. PRIZES** will be awarded at the Fall Cocktail Party.
- 9. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Bellport Bay Yacht Club, Officers, and Members will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
