


2020 Laser NorCal Championships and Day 1 of the D24 Championships

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. Racing Rule 40 is changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices (code flag Y need not be displayed).
- 1.3. All hails will use the last four digits of the sail number. If there is a duplicate, a "simple black line" under one of the sail numbers will be sufficient to indicate to the Race Committee that all six digits are required for identification.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to Laser Standard, Laser Radial, and Laser 4.7.
- 2.2. Eligible competitors may enter by completing the online registration form on the official event website: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20828</u>
- 2.3. Competitors will be required to agree to a waiver of liability as a condition of eligibility. This waiver may be completed either during online registration or at the event check-in.
- 2.4. To compete in the D24 Championships a competitor must be a member of the International Laser Class Association. Competitors who are not members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association, may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority <u>www.laser.org</u>.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee is \$25 for Juniors and \$40 for all others. Entries must be completed on or before 2000 hours September 16, 2020.
- 3.2. Entries received after 2000 hours September 16, 2020 will be subject to a \$15 late fee.
- 3.3. Registration closes as 0800 hours on September 19, 2020.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at check in and on line at registration website above.

6. VENUE

6.1. Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys within a 3 mile radius of Walton Lighthouse. See venue photo Attachment A on event website.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. One (1) race will constitute a regatta.
- 7.2. It is the intention of the organizing authority to run 3 races.
- 7.3. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8. SUPPORT BOATS

- 8.1. Support and coach boats must register at the Race Office during the check-in period. During racing, support boats shall monitor the race committee VHF channel 68 and remain more than 50 yards from the course area, except when asked to assist by the race committee.
- 8.2. Support and coach boats shall berth as directed by the Santa Cruz Harbor Master.

9. BERTHING

9.1. Boats shall be kept in the designated areas of berthing area. See SC Harbor supplemental information in Attachment B on event website.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. Prizes will be given to the overall winners in each registered class division.
- 10.2. The number of prizes will be adjusted to suit the number of competitors pre-registered in each division. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 10.3. Junior sailors will be competing for the Laser NorCal Schuyler Perpetual Trophy.

11. RISK, DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY, & PERSONAL CONDUCT

- 11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk (see Rule 4, Decision to Race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 11.2. Competitors will accept full responsibility for all their actions during any activity related to this event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
