#### 1 RULES

1.1 The series races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats 20 feet or shorter

## 3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Dates of racing: June 11 & 25, July 9 & 23, Aug 6 & 20, Sept 3 & 17
  Other dates may be added by the Race Organizer/Portsmouth Fleet Captain
- 3.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1855 hours
- 3.3 As many races as conditions allow will be run each night

# 4 VENUE

4.1 Races will be run on Lake Sydney Lanier, Chattahooche Bay, more or less in the area between Lake Lanier Sailing Club and Aqualand Marina.

# 5 COURSES

5.1 The courses to be sailed will be designated by the Race Committee before each race using permanent US Army Corps marks, Lake Lanier Sailing Club marks and/or temporary marks as established by the Race Committee.

#### 6 SCORING

6.1 Scoring will be based on USSailing, North American Portsmouth Yardstick calculated handicaps

#### 7 PRIZES

- 7.1 Series trophy(s) will be based on a boats Best 50% of finishes, in order to encourage participation whenever possible but not penalizing you for having an active life
- 7.2 Any fleet with more than 5 boats participating in 5 of the 10 weeks will also receive a One Design trophy
