Notice of Race

1. Rules

- **1.1** The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Class Rules of Harbor 20 Fleet 6.
- **1.2** Participants shall comply with COVID guidelines while attending shoreside events at IYC.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Open to all WD Schock Harbor 20 Class legal sailboats sailing without spinnakers.
- **2.2** Open to all skippers who are members of Harbor 20 Fleet 6 or the National Harbor 20 Class Association.

3. Entry and Fees

- **3.1** Entry fees are donations to **The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.** Competitors are encouraged to enter online at <u>Regatta Network</u>. The entry fee is \$75.00. Skippers will receive one Goslings hat with entry.
- **3.2** Payment can be made by credit card when entering online or by check made payable to The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society (or abbreviated **LLS**) and delivered at the Skipper's meeting on the IYC Pool Deck on Friday March 19th, 2021.
- **3.3** BBQ Bash tickets are discounted from \$40.00 to \$30.00 for Skippers, Crew, & Guests. Payment for tickets can be made at the Skippers meeting but please email Jim Nuzzo icnuzzo@comcast.net with number of tickets required for planning purposes. Skippers may attend the Awards presentation without purchasing BBQ bash tickets and dining.

4. Schedule

- **4.1** 1700-1900 Friday March 19th, 2021: Skipper's meeting, registration, pick up Skipper's Packet, pick up BBQ tickets, Gosling's Rum social on the IYC Pool Deck.
- 4.2 1000 Saturday March 20th, 2021: First Warning Signal.
- 4.3 1700 Saturday March 20th, 2021: BBQ Bash, Auction and Awards.







5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skipper's meeting and posted on the Regatta Network Event Page for this Regatta.

6. Starting and Racing Area

- **6.1** The Start/Finish line will be in the vicinity of Charlotte Harbor Marker #3
- **6.2** Four Races are planned. One Race constitutes a Regatta.
- **6.3** Course will be Windward/Leeward either once or twice around depending on wind speed and time available. No Races will be started after 1400.

7. Scoring

7.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing will apply. Rule A2 is modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of its race scores, without exclusion. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta

8. Awards

8.1 Awards will be presented for first, second place and third place at the annual BBQ Bash on Saturday March 20th. The Chairman's Trophy will be awarded to the top fundraising boat. Top Team & Top Individual fundraising awards will also be presented.

9. Radio Communication

- **9.1** All boats must have at least 1 working VHF Radio on board capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF Channel 16 and 71.
- **9.2** The Race Committee and IYC Support Boat will monitor VHF Channel 16 and communicate on VHF Channel 71.

10. Insurance

10.1 Each participant shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with aminimum coverage of \$300,000 USD.
