1. RULES:

The regatta is organized and hosted by the Mobile Yacht Club.

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

2. ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 All invited classes are open to all sailors.

3. Invited Classes ENTRIES AND FEES:

- 3.1 All registration shall take place on-line at Regatta Network <u>Online Registration</u>
- 3.2 Sport Boats (Viper 640s, VX1, Melges 24) \$20.00 Entry Fee
- 3.3 Finn Class No Entry Fee
- 3.4 Fish Class No Entry Fee
- 3.5 PHRF Spin and PHFR Non-Spin \$20.00 Entry Fee
- 3.6 Three (3) boats will constitute a class in any one design fleet.
- 3.7 No Yacht Club Charge

4. NUMBER OF RACES:

- 4.1 Five (5) races are scheduled for Sport Boats, Finn, & Fish classes of which one (1) will constitute a series.
- 4.2 PHRF Spin and PHRF Non-Spin 1 Race is Scheduled

6. SAFETY:

All competitors must comply with the State of Alabama's Safer at Home Order and the City of Mobile's Face Covering ordinance. Social distancing is encouraged.

All boats shall comply with United States Coast Guard and State safety equipment regulations. It is the responsibility of each skipper to determine if they should start a race, continue racing, or if wearing a life jacket is appropriate. This does not supersede any class rules or regulations that may require wearing of life jackets while on the water.

7. SUPPORT BOATS:

As races will be sailed back to back, Clubs are encouraged to provide support boats for crew changes that may be required on the water.

8. CHANGES TO RACING RULES:

The Sailing Instructions may change some of the RRS.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

10. SCORING:

Each class shall be scored using the low point system of Appendix A with no races excluded. This changes RRS A2.1.
